Bishop Leonard on Medjugorje: Why I Believe

On the occasion of Ivan's visit to Beauraing (Belgium), where Our Lady appeared to 5 children 33 times back in 1932, Bishop Léonard of Namur gave a splendid homily on August 25th, in front of an immense crowd, of which we give the main points.

What are the most beautiful Churches in the eyes of the Lord? They are the ones so full that they seem to burst. God loves them, because a crowded Church is for the Lord a prophecy of what will occur at the fulfillment of all things, when the Kingdom of God will be all in all! This vision of the Kingdom is proposed to us in today's reading of Rev 22:9 (Feast of St. Bartholomew, 25.08.94): the Kingdom of Heaven is a gift of God that comes from above. The heavenly city welcomes the earthly city and joins the history of our world. The angel speaks of this city as a fiancée whom He loves and who will be united to His bride forever, when we all together will form this Kingdom and we will be this Bride.

This is why the whole Church and the whole Kingdom are summed up and depicted in one woman: the Blessed Virgin Mary. As the Second Vatican Council says: When we look at Mary, we see in advance what humanity will be like, what the Church will be like when she has become the Kingdom of God. Every Marian apparition is like an announcement of the holy city, the Fiancée, the Bride who descends from Heaven from near God. So what else is Mary when she appears to us, if not the prefiguration, the sign, the anticipation of the Holy City that will descend from Heaven?

Today's Gospel has a similar language. You have heard Nathaniel's skepticism: can anything good come from Nazareth? (Jn 1:46). We recognize that every time Mary appeared in the world, as well as in the places where the apparitions were recognized, skepticism immediately spread. Always skepticism and doubt when Our Lady appears! - How can this be? Does Mary appear to little Bernadette Soubirous who lives with her parents in Lourdes? How can this be? Does Mary appear to the three shepherd children of Fatima? How can this be? Does Mary appear in Beauraing in a small corner of Belgium? How can this be? Always, there begins the skepticism and doubt. The good attitude is that of Nathaniel when Philip says to him: Come and see! He goes and believes. In order for the signs that God sends us to be recognized, we must come and see.

I personally went to Medjugorje in 1984. I went to Medjugorje, I saw, I was convinced. Nathaniel is shocked by what he has seen and understood and proclaims one of the most beautiful professions of faith in the New Testament: Master, you are the Son of God, you are the King of Israel! (Jn 1:49). He went from skepticism to faith, because he went and there-

fore allowed Jesus to touch his heart. Jesus says to him: You will see greater things than these... You will see the heavens open and the Angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man (Jn 1:50-51): we can apply these theses words to the apparitions that take place in the world.

Does Mary appear too much and talk too much? - I am very impressed by the insistence with which Mary comes to speak to us at this time. How many apparitions of Mary in this century? Rue de Bac in Paris, Pontmain, Lourdes, La Salette, Fatima, Beauraing, Banneux, Kibeo in Rwanda, Medjugorje... Many times people ask me why Mary has been appearing in Medjugorje for so many years already; and again: "How chatty Mary is! In other places Mary said only a few words and appeared for only a few days! This is not in accordance with Mary's discretion!" Personally, I have no idea what is or is not convenient for Mary: what she should say, or what she should not say... I know that if Mary knocks on our doors with such insistence and intensity and for so long, it is because there is a particular urgency for our time. Have you noticed the commitment of our Pope in his mission as a universal pilgrim? Have you seen with what force, with what insistence he draws our attention to the burning problems of today's world? On peace, on the conversion of hearts,

On March 25th, 2025, the visionary, Marija received the following monthly message:

Dear children, The poison of selfishness and hatred rules human hearts and that is why you do not have peace. I am calling you, little children: be love and my extended hands to all those whom you meet. The tenderness of my father-in-law

The inhabitants of Heaven are our friends, and some show us their love with a gentle touch and a particular type of humor, like my father-in-law (I call St. Joseph my father-in-law, since he is the spouse of my Heavenly Mother). Every year, we offer him a thirty day consecration: we pray for 30 days before his feast day on March 19th. But during a short stay in Italy, I missed four of the thirty days. What a shame!

Back home, I realized I had lost the key to our "little Bethlehem," a peaceful place in our garden where I go every day to pray, in the intimacy of the Holy Family. There, I find life-size statues of St. Joseph, Mary, and the baby Jesus laying on the straw...

Unable to find the key, I prayed to St. Joseph and asked him to find it for me. But nothing happened... Knowing his kindness, I figured he must have a good reason for not granting my wish, but what could it be? After March 19th, I made up the four days I was missing from my thirty day commitment. Then behold, on the evening of the fourth day, I took my handkerchief out of my pocket, and... there it was, the key!

It made me smile! St. Joseph is very good at counting, which is to be expected from a carpenter! And he seemed to be saying to me, "You promised me thirty days, so I waited until you finished them all before answering your call!"

This is also a beautiful lesson for our prayer life: every prayer offered from the heart is of great value to the Lord; He awaits it like a precious treasure, which He will use divinely. Making a holy hour in prayer or not makes a significant difference to the Lord, for ourselves and for the world. Through negligence, we miss so many opportunities to grow in holiness! We remain in our lowliness instead of being enriched by the true peace of God, which is what we most long for! We Will celebrate St. Joseph the Worker on May 1st. Don't Miss Him!

How far does Mercy extend?

Screams, bloodcurdling howls, insults, blasphemies, the most abject obscenities, and relentless threats... It's a very young voice that cuts to the core. It almost sounds like a child.

Mother Teresa's sisters—the Missionaries of Charity—found Pearl in the street and took her in half-dead, as they do for most of the residents of this impoverished shelter. For years, Pearl has borne

the deadly marks of AIDS on her body. Since her arrival, she has violently unleashed her despair on anyone who comes near her.

Surprisingly, this house is not located in a poor neighborhood of Calcutta but in one of America's most prestigious cities: Washington, D.C. Has Mother Teresa, the champion of the poorest of the poor, changed her mission and begun working within one of the world's wealthiest cities? What is she doing here, in her small cotton veil and worn sandals?

Accompanied by a few sisters, her goal was to find people like Pearl, condemned to a slow death because they were born into poverty and unable to escape it.

Mother Teresa's sisters feared nothing! They had seen everything, heard everything, and learned to overcome horror with a smile. For them, it was about sowing love where violence reigned, about eradicating evil of any kind, by acting in the same way as Jesus, their divine Master: with gentleness, love, patience, mercy, and joy.

Every day, every moment, the sisters take turns tending to Pearl, condemned to an untimely death. They provide food and care, change her clothes and sheets, trim her toenails, and show her immense kindness. Pearl, for her part, hurls insults and abuse at the sisters in despair, as if seeking revenge for all the atrocities during her miserable existence. Yet the sisters, unperturbed, continue to serve her, their smiles undiminished.

One day, a glimmer of hope pierces the antechamber of death. Pearl begins to open her heart, seeing the sisters' continued kindness toward her. She asks one of them, "Why are you so nice to me when I constantly insult you?"

This is the moment the sister has been waiting for, the moment to break the ice. She must seize the opportunity. She replies, "Our God told us that you are the body of Christ. That is why we treat your body with respect and love."

Pearl is stunned. She thinks she's dreaming. No one has ever spoken to her like this! The sister isn't joking! After a moment of silence, Pearl's tone completely changes. She asks, "Now wait... You mean your God told you that?"

"Yes," the sister replies.

"Well then, I would really like to know your God! If this God tells you to treat me this way, I want to know that God!"

From an Interview with Ivan Dragicevic

In November 2011, Mimi Kelly, of the *MIR Group* in New Orleans, interviewed the visionary Ivan Dragicevic, who has had daily apparitions of the Mother Queen of Peace since 1981. Ivan spoke in English.

Mimi: What is the greatest thing that I, as a person, can do to spread Our Lady's messages?

Ivan: Our Lady invited everyone in the world to be apostles, every believer can be an apostle for evangelization. Pray for evangelization, especially the evangelization of the family, evangelization for the Church today and in the world. This is what Our Lady is asking of all of us. Pray for this intention.

Mimi: The best way to evangelize is through our prayer, our example... or how?

Ivan: Our Lady recommends that we go to the adoration of Jesus. In worship you meet Jesus, and when you meet Jesus, He tells you everything you need. After you start worshipping, everything else is easier.

Mimi: We are so fortunate in New Orleans to be in an area where there are many chapels of worship and so many opportunities.

Ivan: First comes family prayer, then worship will be much easier. It is important to begin worship in the family.

Mimi: What did you see in Heaven?

Ivan: In 1984 Our Lady told me that I would go to see Heaven. She came to me to tell me that she would take me to Heaven. It was a Thursday. On Friday, Our Lady talks to me for a few minutes. I am on my knees, I get up, and Our Lady remains at my left side. Our Lady takes my left hand. I take three steps, and Heaven opens up. I take three more steps and I'm standing on a small hill. The hill is similar to that of the Blue Cross in Medjugorje. Below I see Heaven. I see people walking smiling, dressed in long robes of red, blue, gold. People ask me what people look like. They are singing, a song in the distance. It is very difficult to describe. People ask me how old they are, maybe 30-35 years old; They pray, they sing, together with so many angels. I heard the songs in the distance, the angels sing, very difficult to describe. It brings to mind the Gospel where it says: "Those things which eye has not seen, nor ear has heard..." (1Cor 2:9) That is why Our Lady has come all these 30 years, as a guide for us, reserving a place in heaven for all of us.

Mimi: Our Lady has appeared many times and in many places. Has she spoken with you about other apparitions?

Ivan: Our Lady did not speak to me of any other apparition. I can't answer for the other visionaries, Mirjana, Jakov, Ivanka, Vicka, or Marija.

Mimi: Do you know if every seer is getting the same ten secrets, or are there many secrets?

Ivan: A lot of people ask me the same question. Our Lady does not give six visionaries 60 different secrets. Some secrets are the same. When I stay in Medjugorje in the summer, when most of the visionaries are present, I talk to some of them when we go for coffee, especially with Jacov and Mirjana. We talk about the same secrets.

Mimi: It will be interesting to know all this. Does Virgin ever have you a specific message for some country, in particular for America?

Ivan: Our Lady always speaks for the world. She never gives any specific message for a nation or country, or for any religion. She always gives a universal message. That is why every 25th of the month she always says, "My dear children," and ends with "Thank you for having responded to my call."

She is a mother who speaks to all her children. Our Lady has told me a couple of times, "I know my children are trying to live my message. If people are trying, that's a very positive step." Living in today's world, especially in this time, is sometimes difficult, even for me. I'm trying to do it every day. We need to follow, to follow Our Lady's messages. We must always fight to live the messages. We need to put the most important thing first. Everything will be easier if we put Jesus first

Mimi: Your mission is to pray specifically for whom?

Ivan: I am praying for priests and for vocations in the Church.

Mimi: Did Our Lady give you something to write, to publish later?

Ivan: I've been working on my book for some time. The book is half finished. I need more time. Many papers are on my table. The last two years I've been so busy traveling and speaking in churches. Our Lady gives me things privately especially for priests, young people, families and children. I give examples from my family and some examples from myself.

Mimi: How can we find joy in the situation of our world today?

Ivan: Joy, joy, joy: it can only be in Jesus. No one can give joy but Jesus. As you read the Bible, you will see joy. This is what Our Lady asks, to read the Bible. Our Lady asks for confession to purify ourselves from sin. When the Holy Spirit and grace are in your heart, there is a river of love. A river of joy then comes into your heart. Remove all negativity and you will be open to the Holy Spirit.

Father Xavier's Impression of Medjugorje

When I came, I was thinking that seven days was too much. What am I going to do for seven days?

The first day, when I went to Apparition Hill, it was raining, and we were still walking, and I would see a lot of people walking. Then something gave me peace when we reached Our Blessed Mother, the statue of Our Blessed Mother. I really felt so amazing, an inexplicable moment that I experienced there.

Then we were coming back, and the rain never stopped. I never felt like the drizzling was falling on us. I felt like it was falling away from me. It was such a blessing.

On the second day, I was saying, "Six days is not enough for us. We need more days."

I've heard a lot of things about Medjugorje since 2005. I heard a lot of good things about this place, but I never had a conviction. Even when Marina talked about Medjugorje and she said, "Father, you've got to go. You've got to go." I said, "Yes, yes, wait." But I never gave her any word.

One day, she was coming to the office, then I was coming from my home to the office. Something happened and we decided very quickly to go to Medjugorje. I was sitting in the conference room then said, "Okay, let us call Cimela."

We called you and you took the call on the first ring I think, and said, "Father! I was thinking about you! What's going on?"

"Okay, we're ready to go."

Cimela: What's crazy is when they called me, we didn't have any pilgrims. We were going to cancel. We fasted, our whole

team fasted because we didn't have anybody signing up and we were like, "I guess we're not going to do pilgrimages anymore."

Then you guys called and said you wanted to bring your parish. And then I thought, Wow, Our Lady is saying, "Don't quit yet."

Fr. Xavier: Now I feel like I want to go back and I want to stay another two weeks. This is what I felt in Lourdes, this kind of peace...

I want to spend at least two weeks in Medjugorje and two weeks Lourdes.

Don't doubt until you come here. First of all, you have to convince yourself by leaving. Come and experience and then you can decide whether you can come or not next time. Until then, don't decide. Don't doubt. This is such a peaceful place.

Blessed Mother is always present whenever I celebrate any sacraments. I always imagine that Blessed Mother is present, especially when I celebrate Mass, I always picture that Blessed Mother is present with all the saints.

During the pandemic, whenever the church was closed to the public and we were celebrating Mass without any people, but I kept all the regular Masses, like four Masses. I did all the four Masses.

But I was convinced in that moment that all of those people who were coming regularly to the Mass, their guardian angels and the saints are present in the church for the people who are regularly attending. So I kept all of them. I never missed any Masses during the pandemic.

From that moment, all the more I feel that Blessed Mother is present. So today, of course, I feel that now, the presence of the Blessed Mother who wants to come to us and be with us and tell us that person is a blessing, everyone. It's not about our sin. It's about the mercy God has for us.

When I was climbing Apparition Hill, I felt so much peace. I cannot explain it with words, but you have to live it. That's the first moment that I got it, that opened me to peace and opened me to joy.

Then when we were in the Mass in the evening outside with all the priests, it was so beautiful looking at all the pilgrims. There's so many people who come here.

That brings my memory back to India, where Our Blessed Mother appeared and did the miracles. Now, millions and millions of people go there. I remember because I did my high school there. Since I was living there for four years in that place, I could see thousands and thousands of people who are Muslims and Hindus who are not believers of Christ, but they come to ask Our Blessed Mother to intercede for them. They come with great faith and conviction and Our Blessed Mother, and there are lot of miracles that happen. There are thousands and thousands of miracles that happen to Hindus and Mus-

The sisters then quickly called the priest, the Chaplain of the home. He came to see Pearl several times. He shared the Word of God with her frankly, explaining the most significant moments in the life of Jesus. Pearl didn't miss a word of it. Fascinated, she listened intently, her eyes wide with wonder. She was thirsty for more. When the priest spoke to her about the Eucharist, explaining the meaning of the Last Supper and the Mass, she exclaimed, "If that's what Mass is, then I want to receive Communion!"

There wasn't a second to lose. The priest baptized her, administered the sacrament of Confirmation, and gave her her First Holy Communion. After welcoming Jesus into her heart, she said, "This is the first time a man has entered into me, not to take advantage of me, but to give me everything!"

She then confided the tragedy of her life: "My mother was a drug addict. When I was ten, she forced me into prostitution on the street. She needed the money I earned to buy her drugs. How many men, and sometimes women, have abused me these past ten years... I can't even count them anymore! I contracted AIDS and now I'm going to die; I'm only twenty... But now I'm so happy to have Jesus!"

For the first time in her life, Pearl felt a profound inner peace. The next day, Pearl exchanged a few words with the nuns and noticed they were wearing wedding rings. She asked them, "Are you married?"

"We are not married to a man," they replied. "But we are the spouse of Jesus."

"What? One can become the spouse of Jesus? Is that true? Is that possible? Then I want to become His bride too! But... why would he want to marry a failure like me, who was a prostitute for ten years and is going to die of AIDS?" The sisters had tears in their eyes. They looked at each other in silence, overcome with emotion, unable to hide it.



As night fell, they wondered, "What can we do? How can we give her what she wants? We must call Mother Teresa immediately! She will tell us what to do. This girl is going to die soon..."

Mother Teresa's answer seemed obvious to them. She understood everything at once. There was no room for discussion. Not a single moment should be wasted.

Now what happened the next day remains a secret of their community. Nevertheless, a few days later, Pearl went back to the heavenly Father, wearing the habit of the Missionaries of Charity.

Dearest Gospa, what will you do with the countless lost sheep who today, like Pearl, cry out their despair in the face of this cruel world? We beg you, go to them and enfold them in your maternal tenderness! Awaken us from the sleep of our souls; we want to work with you so that the miracles of Mercy may multiply!

Medjugorje helped Massimo overcome addiction

Drugs are a one-way street, in which the more you go on, the more impossible it becomes to reverse gear and go back. In the story of Massimo, who has just returned from a trip to Medjugorje that healed his body from his obsessive drug addiction, but above all healed the wounds of his soul, the small Croatian town was an oasis of salvation that allowed him to change his life and start a new path. In the book, *Dear Children, Thank You*, by Fr. Paolo Zorza, the young Italian recounted how the encounter with Our Lady of Medjugorje had the strength to reshuffle his existence and finally bring order to the chaos into which he had fallen.

Our Lady's hand, always outstretched to those who want to believe, grabbed Massimo and prevented him from sinking further into that endless abyss in which drugs had imprisoned him: seven long years of drug addiction had deprived him of the will and the possibility of enjoying life outside the slavery to which he had condemned himself. When a nun spoke to him about Medjugorje, he insulted her and sent her away, not being a believer or interested in anything that concerned the Church or God. But when you hit rock bottom, there are few holds on to which you can cling: in one of the worst moments of crisis in his life as a drug addict, Massimo considered the proposal to make the pilgrimage that he had previously so vehemently refused. He decided, therefore, to spend three days in Medjugorje, ignoring how much that place had the power to penetrate even the most hidden recesses of the human soul and turn it upside down from within.

When he arrived in Medjugorje for his three-day pilgrimage, Massimo was blessed to meet Jelena, one of the two women who

on the crisis and the importance of the family? The Blessed Virgin intervenes with this insistence because she is convinced that the years we are living in are decisive for the history of humanity. Personally, I explain in this way Mary's persistence in speaking to us, in calling us to conversion again and again.

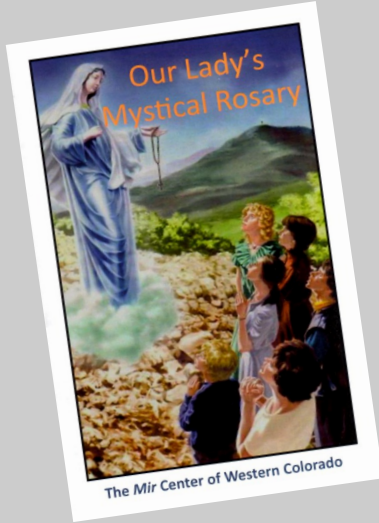
The fruits of Medjugorje are blessed fruits. I am often a witness to these fruits through the confidences and testimonies I receive: conversions, rediscovery of prayer, love for peace, return to the sacraments, to the Eucharist, return to penance and fasting... For peace in the world, in families and in our hearts, I would like to invite you to welcome into your lives – and mine – these pressing appeals, especially those to prayer and fasting. Jesus himself said that there are demons that cannot be cast out except by fasting and prayer (Mt 17:21).

I make myself a simple repeater of what Mary says everywhere and I invite you to conversion of heart through prayer and fasting. In this regard, I invite you to create a corner in every home for personal and family prayer, and to keep the Churches open, attending them for visits, adoration, the rosary (it is also the best means of protecting them from vandalism). For fasting he was struck by the family who hosted him in Medjugorje and who invited him on Fridays to share bread and water with them: so even today he finds one day a week to fast. If Jesus and Mary speak to us - concludes the Bishop - it is not to frighten us, but to call us insistently to conversion. Everything you do to grow in prayer and fasting, to open your hearts and offer yourselves to the love of Jesus, will be a blessing for all humanity. This will be a step towards peace of heart and towards world peace.

lins. Those are not Catholics and those are not Christians, but they receive more miracles than any of the Catholics. That is Our Lady of Good Health. I see that same conviction that people all over the world, from New Zealand to Australia, from South Korea, and I meet these people and see how much conviction, how much faith they have in Our Blessed Mother. They all come, not just like a tourist place to visit someone, but they come here to live their faith. That's the most impressive thing that I encountered here. That opens my heart to happiness, to the joy that is felt in this place.

When I read Mirjana's book, *My Heart Will Triumph* I encountered that Our Blessed Mother appeared, there was joy for her, but at the same time, she and her family and the whole village went through such a great pain. But all people have understood it's for a good cause. That's what we have to stand for. If anything happens, we should know that it's for a good cause, that God has allowed us to go through that pain or maybe tribulations, but we should not give up. Our faith is not to give up, but to persevere, endure, any suffering, any pain in order to gain the Kingdom of God, the joy of our hope. Come and live. You yourself have to experience the joy. Everyone has to experience the joy and spread the joy and spread the peace. First of all you have to live that peace and joy. So come and see...

had the gift of interior locutions. He spent a lot of time with her, in which they talked for a long time; then the young man felt the urgent need to close himself in solitary prayer and, subsequently, to take part in the collective prayers of his group on the Mt. Kricevac. The experience was devastating: the difficulty in climbing along the path of the mountain, the weakness caused by the drugs he had in his body represented the first awareness of a situation that could no longer go on. The descent seemed easier to him, even if he could not explain why. When Massimo decided to leave Medjugorje and to resume his journey along the Croatian coast, between the sea, the discos and the entertainment, he perceived a feeling of confusion, the sense of a sudden emptiness, a terrible oppression. Bursting into tears, he decided to return immediately to Medjugorje, from which he never moved. There had been many attempts to stop taking drugs, including hospitals, clinics, doctors, communities, but none had ever really worked and, on the contrary, he had found himself stuck deeper and deeper in the dark tunnel of drugs. A few days in Medjugorje healed the wounds of his soul that, at a certain point, no longer needed to fill its emptiness by resorting to the ephemeral illusions of a pill: Medjugorje heals through faith, performs the miracle of arousing a new need for life, richer than that happiness that is neither material nor ephemeral. The construction of one's own spiritual maturity and of the relationship with God is something, on the other hand, that prepares man for eternity, building little by little that interior and moral support that is very different and more lasting than the illusion of happiness that happens with drugs.

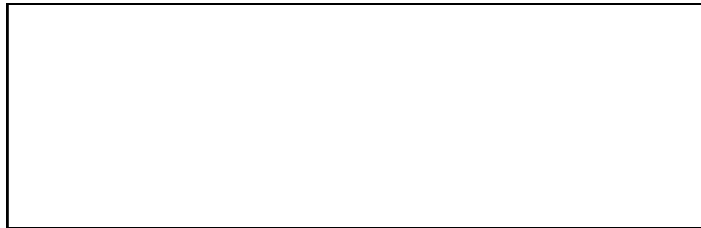
