Jakov's Christmas Apparition

At the last daily apparition to Jakov Colo on September 12th, 1998, Our Lady told him that henceforth he would have one apparition a year, every December 25th, on Christmas Day. This is also how it was this year. The apparition began at 2:25 pm and lasted 9 minutes. Our Lady came with little Jesus in her arms. Through Jakov, Our Lady gave the following message:



"Dear children, You are, and you are called, 'children of God'. If only your hearts would feel that immeasurable love which God has for you, your hearts would adore and give thanks to Him at every instant of your life. Therefore, little children, today, on this day of grace, open your hearts and implore the Lord for the gift of faith; so that you could truly become worthy of the name 'children of God' who, with a pure heart, give thanks to and honor their Heavenly Father. I am beside you and am blessing you with my motherly blessing."

Jakov Colo, together with Vicka, had the experience of going with Our Lady to see Heaven, Purgatory and Hell. Jakov is 50 years old. The youngest of the visionaries of Medjugorje, he was born in Sarajevo on March 6, 1971. He was just ten years old when the apparitions of Our Lady began. He was orphaned at an early age: he lost his mother at only 12 and his father at 13, and grew up with his uncles (Marija's parents) in Medjugorje. He is married and has three children and lives in Medjugorje. He coordinates the charity **Mary's Hands** which is based in Medjugorje

Jakov: "*From the time Our Lady first appeared to me, my life has entirely changed. Now, I pray more and go to Mass every evening. I try, more and more, to fulfill the messages that Our Lady gives us. I feel I'm closer to God now. I believe we have to pray that God's plans will be realized. I now want to live as a Christian. I begin the day with prayer and I help wherever necessary. To me, the Mass means an encounter with the living God. Our Lady always tells us to pray more.*"

On November 25th, 2021, the visionary, Marija, received the following monthly message:

“Dear children! I am with you in this time of mercy, and I am calling all of you to be carriers of peace and love in this world where, through me, little children, God is calling you to be prayer and love, and an expression of Heaven here on earth. May your hearts be filled with joy and faith in God; that, little children, you may have complete trust in His holy will. That is why I am with you, because He, the Most High, is sending me among you to encourage you to the hope; and you will be peacemakers in this peaceless world. Thank you for having responded to my call.”

The value of suffering

Father Jozo summarized the main messages of the Blessed Mother in 5 points, called "the 5 stones of Medjugorje", for those who wish to become true "apostles of her love". If I may, I would like to add a sixth stone, that is so crucial today, namely the Christian understanding of suffering, which Mary has expressed especially to Vicka. When suffering knocks on our door, Mary always helps us to suffer with Jesus and not without Jesus! The difference is huge, as big as the difference between day and night, or between hope and despair.

Recently, a young mother came from Colombia to Medjugorje with her severely disabled 3-year-old daughter, in order to entrust her to Our Lady. This was a very severe handicap, as the child could not see, hear or walk, and could only be fed through a tube. This mother, Maria José, was radiant because she had been praying for years and one could clearly see on her face the imprint of God, a God of joy who gives himself to the human soul in a special way when they are undergoing trials.

Maria José was able to go to the Magnificat Center and was present during the apparition of Our Lady with the visionary, Marija. As soon as she arrived, Maria José was able to meet with Marija, and when Marija approached the child, she looked at her for a long time, clearly seized with immense tenderness. She then whispered these words: "This mother and the Madonna are one!"

Marija's spontaneous reaction was magnificent! It shows the value of life when suffering is offered! Maria José will never forget these luminous words in the future, when she undergoes trials.

"Dear children, today I invite you to surrender completely to God... Little children, do not be afraid, for I am with you, even when you think that there is no way out and that Satan reigns. I bring you peace. I am your Mother and the Queen of Peace. I bless you with the blessing of joy, so that God may be everything to you in life." (July 25th, '88)

"Little children... Sin will reign, and you will not be strong. But if you are mine, you will win, for your refuge will be the Heart of my Son Jesus." (July 25th, '19)

The Christmas novena

We have entered into the novena before Christmas, and here in Medjugorje there are some very beautiful prayer initiatives. For instance, the traditional Mass at 6 a.m. each day of Advent, with a church that is full, especially with young people; also many rosaries prayed on Apparition Hill... On this occasion I would like to recall a significant event that occurred in December 1991 during the war, because I see in it an analogy with the ordeal that the world is going through today.



For the local prayer group and pilgrims, our Lady would give a special message every year on December 16th, in order to better live the novena before Christmas. That year, in 1991, given the horrors of the war, we expected a dramatic message... What kind of Christmas would she announce? But it was quite the opposite! These are her words: ***"Dear children, may this Christmas be for you the most joyful of all Christmases! May your families be joyful as we were joyful in the stable when my Son was born!"***

At the time, we were surprised, but then everything quickly became clear. The key is that when things are going wrong,

Laurie, Leo and Coming Home

What was it like to come back to Medjugorje? It felt like coming home. I think that's why I'm crying so much because it feels like I'm with my brother. I've lost both my parents and my brother. I lost them within 13 months.

I was the youngest. My brother was six years older than me. He was chronically ill. He was bipolar, and took a lot of medicine to keep himself sane, and that hurt his heart and his kidneys. He was on dialysis. He had the body of a 90 year old even though he was in his sixties.

I had a sister that died when I was two. He was the one that was my hero all during my childhood because my mom and dad were very devastated by the death of my sister.

I woke up with a heavy heart on Saturday not really knowing why, and then it dawned on me. It was because it was November 6th. The anniversary of my brother's death was on Saturday. I didn't know I was going to be grieving when I got here, but I woke up and I had a very heavy heart.

That day our guide, Miki, took us on the walking tour, I was hanging back and kind of tearful. Sandy was walking back with me, and she was trying to help me with my spirits. She was asking me questions. I told her I was heavy because I was thinking about my brother, Leo. She said, "Tell me what you liked about him."

I said, "He was always there for me. He was exasperating because he was bipolar. He was very entitled. He was very smart mentally, but emotionally, he was like ten or eleven so it was exasperating to be around him sometimes, but I loved him."

"He found his calling. He was an awesome, smart Bridge player, one of the best. He was a Life Master. He won a lot of tournaments, and he evangelized while he was playing Bridge."



"He had the purest heart. He had a miracle that happened to him. He was on dialysis for many years, and in the last five years of his life, he was able to get off of it. The doctors had no understanding of why. During those years, he wrote poetry. He wrote poetry on Jesus, and he handed it out to everybody. Wherever he went, he had it in his pocket, and he would give it to people like cashiers or if he went to a restaurant or if he went anywhere. "He was such a beautiful person."

I told her all this, and she looked at me and she said, "What was his last name?" I said, "Zigrang."

She stopped, and she looked at me. She knew him. Not only did she know him, but she lived on the same floor as both my mom and my dad and my brother in a condo they lived in for the last 20 years of their lives.

She told me stories about them. My brother brought her a poem. My mom and dad were very quirky. My mom was very faithful. My mom would walk to church every day. It was about half a mile from their condo. My dad would follow her in the car because he didn't want anything to happen to her, but he didn't want to go to Mass. He started and did that for many years. Then they got to the point where she would ride with him and he would go to Mass. They were kind of constantly bickering but really loved each other. They made it to 69 years of marriage.

She told me these things about my family. It made me feel like I was at home. I knew that Our Blessed Mother orchestrated this meeting. It was the Holy Spirit. She came on pilgrimage. I didn't know her. I had never seen her or met her. I didn't live in the condo. She lived there with them for like ten years. We had no idea. I was able to laugh about it, and it made me feel like I'm not alone, and she is not alone.

The Story of the Korean Statue in Medjugorje

South Koreans are among the many groups of pilgrims from around the world that visit Medjugorje in large numbers each year. In fact there is a very visual feature of Medjugorje that connects to Korea – the statue of Our Lady Queen of Peace, located and blessed at the top of Apparition Hill in 2001, where it is said Our Lady's first apparition took place in 1981. Millions of pilgrims have since climbed the hill of apparitions specifically to pray at the statue and petition Our Lady.

The beautiful sculpture was commissioned and presented to the Medjugorje parish as a gift from a Korean couple in thanksgiving for a wonderful miracle they and their son received through Our Lady's intercession. The young boy was both deaf and dumb and his parents brought him to Medjugorje in the hope of healing. When the pilgrimage had ended there was no change in the boy's condition. While his father returned home his mother decided to remain with her son in Medjugorje until Our Lady granted them a grace. She rented a small apartment and daily climbed Apparition Hill and sometimes Mt Krizevac, carrying the child in her arms. After three months, when climbing Mt Krizevac and at the fourth Station of the Cross (Jesus meets his Mother), she was overcome with an immense sense of love and unity with the Mother of Jesus, sharing the cross carried by Jesus and her own son, and was able to surrender and proclaim her 'Fiat'.

After returning to her apartment the boy's mother began to prepare something to eat while the child was in the other room.

Fatima, Medjugorje and the 'Russia' Prophecy

As tensions rise between the United States and Russia over activities in Ukraine, talk of World Wars suddenly does not seem far-fetched. The danger is real. 150,000 heavily armed Russian troops stationed on Ukraine's border are ready for battle.

A year ago Vladimir Putin warned a group of Western Journalists saying: "You people in turn do not feel a sense of the impending danger – this is what worries me. How do you not understand that the world is being pulled in an irreversible direction? I don't know how to get through to you anymore."

It seems Russia and Ukraine are set for a major conflict that ultimately could lead to a sequence of unpredictable events. China and Taiwan, Israel and Iran all appear ready to settle some scores. Here at *Mystic Post*, we find it fascinating and important that Catholic prophecy predicted years ago many of today's unfolding events. Events that are not just matters for secular historians to unpack but the future of Christianity, itself, is mysteriously tied to Russia and the Virgin Mary.

At Fatima, Our Lady warned the world that Russia would spread "error" throughout the world. This error turned out to be atheist communism. Lenin himself said that the goal of communism was to rid Christianity from the world. And he put in motion the most direct attack on religion in the history of the world. Fatima's secrets mysteriously spotlighted Russia's central role in Our Lady's prophecies concerning future events that we are seeing unfold today.

Vatican insider Father Malachi Martin claims to have read the 3rd secret of Fatima. He kept his oath to never disclose its full contents but in a radio interview with Art Bell he had some extraordinary things to say about the Third Secret, Russia, and Ukraine. He told Art Bell: "Sister Lucia's single-page letter of the "Third Secret" covers three topics:

- +A Physical chastisement of nations
- +A spiritual chastisement

The central function of Russia in the two which in fact, the physical and spiritual chastisements are to be girded on a fateful timetable in which Russia is the linchpin.

In Father Malachi Martin's book, *The Last Prophet*, he wrote that "The 3rd secret will involve Russia and Ukraine. He said: Russia's role in the Vision of Fatima is very important because if we're to believe the Vision of Fatima, salvation for the world, the cure for the world's ills, will start in the Ukraine and in Russia,



and that was why the Virgin in the Fatima vision of 1917 was supposed to have spoken directly about Russia and that Russia first of all has to be cured of her errors and then she will help the entire world to get better and to cure itself of its sins. It's a very bizarre message in that sense because one would have said that salvation was going to come from the West as we always think because we are Westerners. But no, according to the message of Fatima, salvation will come from the East, and particularly, from Ukraine and from the State of Russia itself, which is extraordinary.

Are today's events in Russia and Ukraine a sign that the world is heading towards the fulfillment of the Fatima and Medjugorje Russia prophecy? On August 25, 1991 Our Lady said that Medjugorje is the continuation and fulfillment of Fatima.

On May 13, 1981, at the height of the cold war and atheist communism, the Soviet Union attempted to assassinate Pope John Paul II. A little over one month later, on June 24, 1981, Our Lady began to appear to six children in the communist county of Yugoslavia. Then in October of 1981, Our Lady of Medjugorje revealed her "Russia Prophecy" which ties Medjugorje to Fatima in a powerful way. She said "**Russia will come to glorify God the most, the West will make civilization progress but without God and will act like their own creator.**" These words from Our Lady were documented by the great Marian expert Father Rene Laurentin.

Pope John Paul II had this to say about Medjugorje, Fatima and Russia: "Look, Medjugorje is a continuation, an extension of Fatima. Our Lady is appearing in communist countries primarily because of problems that originate in Russia".



According to John Paul II's close confidant Bishop Hnilica, soon after the events in Medjugorje began the Pope understood that Our Lady would be central in the fight against communism and that this would be the mission of his pontificate. This would lead to the Consecration of Russia on March 24, 1984. Then on March 24, 1984 Pope John Paul II successfully completed the act of Consecration of Russia to Our Lady's Immacu-

dwelling on the evil does not help the situation, it increases discomfort, stirs up hatred and can even exacerbate wounds. In addition, Satan is very flattered when we talk about his works. On that day, Our Lady helped us to understand that in order to overcome evil, we must do as she does and as the saints show us by example: while taking care of practical necessities, look up to God in prayer, for help comes from Him alone. In doing so, we enable His light to descend and expand, not only upon us but beyond us. Contemplating evil is damaging to us, but contemplating good transforms us, and therefore, even in difficult situations, we can **"be love and an expression of Paradise here on earth"** as Mary tells us in her message. Praying and talking about God's works melts evil without touching it.



It was very cold in the stable, the Holy Family did not even have the basic necessities. The Son of God and Creator of all things had to sleep in a manger for animals! They suffered. But for Joseph and Mary, the joy of Jesus' coming transcended their suffering. The power of their love and prayer closed the door to Satan who was never able to enter their home.

May this Christmas 2021, so full of uncertainties, be an opportunity for each of us to turn away from our screens, to look up to heaven, and with all our heart worship the One who is our sure salvation. We can each reflect on the light of heaven that each soul desires so much, and overcome this darkness of conscience: a modern evil that causes inner death. On the evening of December 25th, during the apparition (at 5:40 p.m.), Mary will be draped in her golden robe and will carry the Child God in her arms and give Him to us. She will bless us with her motherly blessing and rejoice for all the hearts that are open to her, all the hearts that will receive the precious gift of her Child and embrace Him with love.

Did St. Joseph leave?

Did St Joseph leave us on December 8th, at the end of the year dedicated to him? I heard this many times: "How sad that the year of St. Joseph is over!" But that is to misunderstand Saint Joseph! We can compare the 12 months of the year of St Joseph to a time of discovery, a time of intense interaction with his person, his qualities and his goodness. Many experienced true little miracles, as have I.

But after this blessed year, I wish to emphasize one of his virtues that he certainly wishes to share with us, a virtue that is indispensable to walk on the path of holiness. It is his constant concern to be perfectly attentive to



God. St. Joseph is the best model of the "Shema Israel! Hear O Israel!", the prayer that Jesus himself recited at least 3 times a day. I admire Saint Joseph's heart of silence.

Out of humility, aware of the immense responsibility that the Heavenly Father had entrusted to him as shepherd of the Holy Family, he always listened so as not to risk missing a single word from God. A silence of meditation on the Scriptures and the Holy Spirit in him. This is how he grasped God's secrets with his heart and did not let them evaporate with useless words. In a word, he inhabited his own heart that was so full of God.

Joseph had an obedient heart. But to be able to obey well, one has to know how to listen.

"Arise, take the Child and his Mother and go to Egypt..." Satan's plan fomented by King Herod against Jesus fell through thanks to Joseph's obedience!

Can we, too, be silent, so we can listen to God whispering in our hearts, trust in Him, and thereby thwart Satan's plans for our world?

late heart. What followed was an astonishing sequence of events as atheist communism collapsed. The Berlin Wall fell and the Soviet Union's flag came down on Christmas day 1991.

So fast forward to today and to the rising tensions between the United States and Russia and again we see that the prophecies of Fatima and Medjugorje continue to be relevant by predicting the future in an unprecedented way. Few would argue that world elites from the "West", including the United States, are building a future without God. What is less well known is that Christianity in Russia has experienced a mysterious Christian revival.

Now Putin lectures the United States for abandoning its Christian roots. He said, "We see in Europe and the United States, that is the "West", have taken the way where they deny their own roots, including their Christian roots which form the basis of Western Civilization. As she was doing this she looked out of the window and saw pilgrims making their way to Apparition Hill and seemingly singing "Ave Maria". But then she realized that the sound was coming from the child's room and it was her son who was singing! She called out to him and he responded: "When I sing 'Ave Maria' my heart leaps with joy!" The boy had received a miracle. He was no longer deaf and dumb. The euphoric mother immediately telephoned her husband to share the good news. Because of this miracle the woman's husband experienced his own conversion and later became a Catholic. Filled with gratitude the Korean family commissioned a statue dedicated to the Queen of Peace and was given permission to erect it on Apparition Hill as a sign of Our Lady's intercession and her Son's miracle blessing.

They say Our Lady is never outdone in generosity. Since the placing of the Korean family's gift to the parish and their acknowledgement of the miracle, millions of pilgrims have climbed the hill of apparitions to pray at the statue and petition Our Lady the Queen of Peace.

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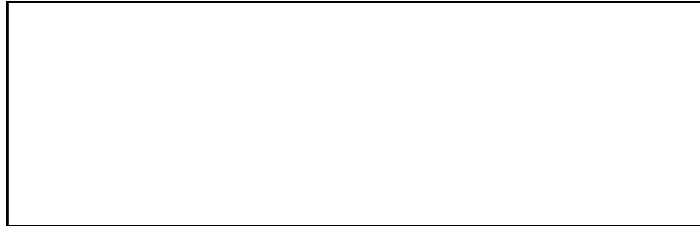
