"I was in Medjugorje in September for the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross. On the first day, crossing the corridor of the hotel, I felt a hand that pushed me strongly from behind. I fell hurting my leg severely. I couldn't climb Apparition Hill and Cross Mountain as I wished to, and as I usually did. I was a pilgrim but I suffered much due to the impossibility of walking and also from the pain. The leg was swollen and badly bruised. Early treatment had had no effect."

"Back in Sardinia in Oristano things gradually got worse despite the care in the clinic. Doctors aspirated blood with large syringes without any improvement. I would look at my swollen leg, full of fluid with severe bruising and multiple incisions for aspiration. The pain became unbearable and I wondered if I would ever recover, if I would be able to walk, if I would ever resume normal activity. I was very demoralized and doctors determined that on Monday, October 22, after therapy, they would decide on surgery. On Sunday, October 21, the inauguration of the "Piazza Regina della Pace" and the blessing of the statue of Our Lady were scheduled in San Nicolò d'Arcidano. I didn't want to miss it. Most everyone told me I should not go but I went to the ceremony accompanied by some friends."

"They accompanied me and supported me to the center of the Square. The seats were all occupied, So I found myself off to the left of Our Lady near the side where she extends her hand. I could see the statue and the stage with the altar."

"The ceremony began with the proclamation of the new name of the Square, followed by the procession with the confraternities, the girls in traditional costumes, the altar boys, the bishop with the priests, the prefect with the mayors. Then the unveiling of the statue of the Queen of Peace that appeared to the many faithful gathered that evening in all its splendor."

"I felt such a severe pain in my leg, I didn't know if I could remain for the rest of the ceremony. Maybe those who advised me against coming were right. While I was struggling with these thoughts, I saw Our Lady very close to me. I couldn't understand it. I was excited and confused. I rubbed my eyes. To my friend who was close to me I said that in addition to the evil of my leg I was now suffering from an eye disease. She, the Queen of Peace was there, very close to me. She was not a statue, no she was alive and beautiful and she looked at me smiling. During the ceremony, Our Lady approached a second time with the same look, the same smile. I was in great confusion with my heart in turmoil, full of joy and also fear together.

"Then something else that was singular happened to me. I was very worried at the time of holy communion: the pain in the leg became stronger and stronger, until it was unbearable. I was not in a position to stand, let alone to approach the priest for communion who was distant in the crowd of the faithful. I felt an energy that made me rise and support myself using poles that I saw, grabbing them alternately with one hand and then with the other, I came to the priest who gave me the Eucharist. He was the priest with whom I had last been on pilgrimage to Medjugorje."

"The solemn ceremony then came to a conclusion with great joy as the beautiful statue of Our Lady was illuminated and blessed by the bishop. The faithful flocked around the statue to contemplate it more closely, pausing in prayer."

"My friends tried to help me, but I got up on my own and started walking. They pointed out to me that I was walking without limping and I told them that I actually felt that my leg felt lighter. They wanted us to stop and get something to eat, but given the time, I just wanted to go home. On the return journey I felt a very strong, burning heat in my leg. When I got home, the first thing I did was take off my shoe and stocking to look at my leg. I could not believe my eyes: the leg was dry, thin, and the swelling was gone. There were no bruises and no signs of the prior incisions for aspirations, It appeared healthy as if I had never had any problem. I was completely healed."

"My emotion was so great, I did not sleep, I prayed, cried and thanked Our Lady all night. The day after on Monday, October 22nd, it was the day set for treatment in the clinic and for the decision about surgery."

"I showed up all joyful and smiling. The doctor who was already prepared with a large syringe for aspiration exclaimed: "There is nothing to be cheerful about. Do you not know that I must hurt you very much?" Then, finally noting the appearance of my leg, he asked with great wonder: "What happened? The leg has no swelling. There is no need for treatment anymore, it is completely healed!"

"I told the doctor that the day before, although I was very ill, I had been to San Nicolò d'Arcidano for the inauguration of the Square and the blessing of the Statue of the Queen of Peace and that there I had experienced an extraordinary experience of the special presence of Our Lady in that place, As I spoke, the surgeon who was to perform the operation on the leg entered, and said to me sarcastically: 'You can see that Our Lady must have kissed her!'. Without hesitating, I looked at him firmly and replied: 'Doctor, I am sure that it was Our Lady who healed me! I was hurt falling in Medjugorje and Our Lady of Medjugorje herself healed me in the Square just dedicated to her.'" The doctors could only marvel at the sudden recovery. Anna later avoided taking the elevator and climbed on foot to the fifth floor of a friend's house.

On Thursday, November 8, Anna returned to the Piazza Regina della Pace to thank Our Lady and donate as a sign of gratitude, a beautiful silver rose that is now kept in the Parish. On November 12, she testified of her recovery in the prayer meeting of the "Friends of Medjugorje in Sardinia" in the chapel of the archbishop's seminary of Cagliari and on Saturday December 1st in the prayer meeting in the parish church of San Nicolò d'Arcidano. She also testified before the Archbishop of Oristano and several priests. She has returned several times to pray to Our Lady in the Queen of Peace Square. The medical documentation has been completed and will be handed over to the Bishop of Oristano and the Parish Priest of San Nicolò d'Arcidano.

On the evening of March 25th, during the apparition, the translators of the message were gathered in the chapel of the visionary Marija. When they saw her crying during and after the apparition, they wondered what kind of message could cause these tears! Then Marija disappeared as usual into the small sacristy to write down the message received from Our Lady. When she came back to the small group waiting for the message, she exclaimed: "Why do you look so sad?" Then she joyfully read the message quoted above. She beamed with joy, it was as if she was proud of her Heavenly Mother for connecting us - or reconnecting us - to the real answer to the world's problems.

The Blessed Mother did not draw up an endless list for us of what is going wrong today, like the media does, those media outlets that are so quick to destroy any hope. No, she went in the opposite direction, she lifted our eyes to THE SOLUTION that we tend to forget, and which is nevertheless the only solution that is able to save us. Mary really is something! She not only knows the past and the present, but the future as well. Also, she is a mother. If she tells us "Whoever prays does not fear the future and does not lose hope", she knows what she is talking about! She is our Queen, and she gathers up the people who are willing to follow her instructions as a mother and a sovereign, with the confidence of children.

This is wonderful! But it is a small remnant, still too few in number, in spite of Our Lady's pressing appeals over the past 40 years.

My friends, it is an honor for you to be one of them! Resolute hearts are the ones that change the world! Whether political or health-focused, there is no solution which, if it is designed outside of God and without prayer, will save the world. "Every plant that my heavenly Father has not planted will be uprooted" Jesus tells us (Mt 15:13). This is the only valid bulwark that can protect us against the darkness that could overtake us, without forgetting fasting. Let us not look for it elsewhere!

Why is Medjugorje So Important?

Why is Medjugorje so important? Why not just believe in approved apparitions such as Fatima and Lourdes? Every time Our Lady has appeared throughout history, it has been to help guide man back to God from the errors of that particular period in history.

This is a basic teaching of the Church on private revelations. Even the Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us of this purpose of private revelation; "It is not their role to improve or complete Christ's definitive Revelation, but to help live more fully by it in a certain period of history." (CCC, 67)

It is thus, that Medjugorje is more relevant to us today than any other private revelation in the history of Christianity. Medjugorje is THE message of our time. And so, we would do well to listen to what Our Mother has to say to us who are living today.

Furthermore, there is a particular sense of urgency in the messages, more so than in past apparitions

(yet it is also balanced with great hope as well, which separates Medjugorje from condemned apparitions that typically only focus on the negative)

"Dear children! You are not aware of the importance of the messages which God is sending you through me. He is giving you great graces and you do not realize it. Pray to the Holy Spirit for enlightenment. If only you knew how many graces God is giving you, you would pray without ceasing."

"These apparitions are the last for humanity."... "I have come to call the world to conversion for the last time. Later, I will not appear any more on this earth." "These apparitions are the last in the world."

"One day he [Satan] appeared before the throne of God and asked permission to submit the Church to a period of trial. God gave him permission to try the Church for one century. This century is under the power of the Devil, but when the secrets confided to you come to pass, his power will be destroyed. Even now he is beginning to lose his power and has become aggressive. He is destroying marriages, creating division among priests and is responsible for obsessions and murder. You must protect yourselves against these things through fasting and prayer, especially community prayer. Carry blessed objects with you. Put them in your house, and restore the use of holy water."

"A great battle is about to take place. A battle between my Son and Satan. Human souls are at stake."

"I have prayed; the punishment has been softened. Repeated prayers and fasting reduce punishments from God, but it is not possible to avoid entirely the chastisement. Go on the streets of the city, count those who glorify God and those who offend Him. God can no longer endure that."

"My angel, pray for unbelievers. People will tear their hair, brother will plead with brother, he will curse his past life, lived without God. They will repent, but it will be too late.

Now is the time for conversion. I have been exhorting you for the past four years. Pray for them."

"Hurry to be converted. Do not wait for the great sign. For the unbelievers, it will then be too late to be converted. For you who have the faith, this time constitutes a great opportunity for you to be converted, and to deepen your faith. Fast on bread and water before every feast, and prepare yourselves through prayer."

"Dear children! I continually need your prayers. You wonder what all these prayers are for. Look around, dear children, and you will see how much ground sin has gained in this world. Be-

cause of that, pray that Jesus conquers."

"The hour has come when the demon is authorized to act with all his force and power The present hour, is the hour of Satan."

"How many people come to church, to the house of God, with respect, a strong faith, and love of God? Very few! Here you have a time of grace and conversion. It is necessary to use it well."



"Be converted! It will be too late when the sign comes. Beforehand, several warnings will be given to the world. Have people hurry to be converted. I need your prayers and your penance. My heart is burning with love for you. It suffices for you to be converted. To ask questions is unimportant. Be converted. Hurry to proclaim it. Tell everyone that it is my wish, and that I do not cease repeating it. Be converted, be converted. It is not difficult for me to suffer for you. I beg you, be converted. I will pray to my Son to spare you the punishment. Be converted without delay. You do not know the plans of God; you will not be able to know them. You will not know what God will send, nor what He will do. I ask you only to be converted. That is what I wish. Be converted! Be ready for everything, but, be converted. That is all I wish to say to you. Renounce everything. All that is part of conversion. Goodbye, and may peace be with you."

"The sign will come, you must not worry about it. The only thing that I would want to tell you is to be converted. Make that known to all my children as quickly as possible. No pain, no suffering is too great to me in order to save you. I will pray to my Son not to punish the world; but I beseech you, be converted. You cannot imagine what is going to happen nor what the Eternal Father will send to earth. That is why you must be converted! Renounce everything. Do penance. Express my acknowledgement to all my children who have prayed and fasted. I carry all this to my Divine Son in order to obtain an alleviation of His justice against the sins of mankind. I thank the people who have prayed and fasted. Persevere and help me to convert the world."

"Where are the prayers which you addressed to me? My clothes were sparkling. Behold them soaked with tears. Oh, if you would know how the world today is plunged into sin. It seems to you that the world sins no longer, because here, you live in a peaceful world where there is no confusion or perversity. If you know how lukewarm they are in their faith, how many do not listen to Jesus. Oh, if you knew how much I suffer, you would sin no more. Oh, how I need your prayers. Pray!"

Janis: This is our first time. We had been planning on coming for a long time and, I don't know, just circumstances kept us from coming. We were going to bring our mom, originally, but then she got ill. It never really was a good time for her, being sick. Then she passed about five years ago. So we finally decided to make this journey together. We had to come to together. There was no other option.

Kathy: We are going to bring our other sisters back here. There are four of us. We have one that, she was texting me from the Medjugorje prayer group back home, telling me that they were praying for us. They had requests. I brought all their prayer intentions. We're gonna get her here, and we're gonna get the other little sister. And we have a brother. We're gonna get them all here. That's our goal.

Janis: Our goal is to all come back together.

Kathy: We've had two true miracles.

I have a granddaughter that was born with leukemia, not supposed to live, not more than a week probably. She is now 7, in complete remission. Thousands of prayers. Total miracle. I am here to give thanks to God for her.

Then, my daughter had a baby in May. She was 27. 17 days in ICU; almost hemorrhaged to death...She is alive, back at work, and her baby is almost 10 months.

Janis: She's a miracle.

Kathy: The doctors even say, "We don't know why you're here." So up on Cross Mountain and in front of the Blessed Mother, trust me, I was thanking Jesus and thanking the Blessed Mother. Because we prayed. We had a prayer card of the Divine Mercy and a prayer card of the Blessed Mother.

Janis: Hanging in her room at all times.

Kathy: At all times. And They came through. They came through for us. Life is good.

Janis: Lots of peace here. I love it because I feel like there's no distractions. That's what I love about it. There's no distractions. You can just really connect with the Blessed Mother, with God, with Jesus. Everything has been absolutely beautiful and touching and just an inner peace within yourself.

Kathy: I agree with Jan, I think it's peace, but I also feel so much joy. My mom always said, "To Jesus through Mary." We grew up thinking that. And Mom saw the Blessed Mother at her death. Being here just reinforces to me the peace and joy that the Blessed Mother is going to bring us. And She'll be there to take us to Jesus. We just have to—everybody needs to pray the Rosary. I learned on this trip too, it really reinforced to

me that the Rosary really is our greatest weapon. The greatest weapon there is. Everybody needs to know.

Janis: Our mother did see the Blessed Mother when she died. She told us. She was between both worlds almost, sitting on the edge of her bed, and she asked us, "Can you see this?"

And we're like, "Mom, what are you seeing?"

She goes, "Well, heaven of course." And she said, "Don't you see Her?"

And we're like, "Who?"

She goes, "The Blessed Mother and all the gifts."

Kathy: She said, "There are so many gifts for me here."

We said, "Who has gifts for you?"

Both: "The Blessed Mother."

Kathy: The look of joy on my mom's face – there you go again – joy and peace. And she died at exactly the Divine Mercy hour.

Janis: She had a great devotion to Divine Mercy. She's the one who taught us about Medjugorje, Divine Mercy, all these things, before they became as known as what they are now. We were young. And she's taught all of our own children too. All of the grandchildren know all about

this place, they know all about Gran's great devotion to Divine Mercy. We all pray it.

Kathy: And my husband joined the church because he was at my mother's death. He's 64 years old. He's been Protestant all his life and he said, "Your mother's death was so beautiful." So beautiful it brought him to the Catholic faith.


Janis: That's another miracle.

Kathy: At my mom's death, we were all there. Most of the grandkids were there. We were all there together.

Janis: She went down a little bit after she saw the Blessed Mother. She said, "Oh! He's trying to come for me, but I'm not ready yet."

I'm like, "I'm going if Jesus is coming for me."

She waited for all of her kids to be there, waited for the grand-kids, and the three o'clock Divine Mercy hour. We were all there, and we sang the Divine Mercy. Then at the end, we read to her, "Jesus will stand at the bed of the dying." We read the thing at the end that she taught us so well. And she actually opened her eyes, looked at us, and took her last breath at 3:37 on a Friday.

Beware! False mercy?

In the wake of the Feast of Divine Mercy, I would like to provide some useful clarifications to help us understand what true mercy is, and to avoid the many traps of false mercy. The example of Gloria Polo is crystal clear, so concrete, and it struck me deeply.

As a teenager, although of Catholic origin, Gloria had gradually fallen into a dissolute way of life, wanting to imitate her friends who were left to their own devices spiritually. They were sheep without a shepherd! At the age of 16 she found herself pregnant and was frightened. But her friends gave her the "magic key" that could get her out of her predicament: "Do what we do, don't be dumb, abortion is nothing, in an hour

you'll be rid of the problem! And plus, it's free!"

Shortly after her abortion, she had a kind of wake-up call because she felt a strong sickness come over her. Deep down she felt that her lifestyle was "off" and was not leading her to

true happiness. A major question stuck in her mind: "Where am I going to end up with this kind of life? This isn't the right kind of behavior. I'm deteriorating, I'm falling into a hole, there is something wrong with me. I'm going down a wrong path!"

She decided to go see a priest and tell him what she was experiencing, and get some advice for her life so as to follow a better path. She was sincerely looking for the light! She opened her heart to this priest who listened to her talk about her choices, her sins, her downfalls and her deep doubts about the quality of her life. At the end of this story, the priest smiled at her and said, to put her at ease: "Don't worry! You're young, enjoy life, do what your friends are doing, why be different? God is good, he always forgives, don't worry! Go in peace!"

What do you think of this answer? In any case, from that day on, according to her own testimony, Gloria threw herself whole-heartedly into immorality. Why not? After all, hadn't she received the approval of the Church through its representative? Hadn't she been given the green light to blindly follow her instincts and "do what everyone else is doing"? Her soul became filled with darkness as she committed more serious sins, trampling on God's commandments without any scruples. She thought she had found a way to freedom and happiness, but in reality she had received what could be called a "deadly sleeping pill" for her soul. "Dear children," Mary tells us, "you are placing yourselves in the hands of Satan without thinking."

One thing led to another, she became a real pest, full of pride and contempt for others, she mocked God and the Church. Those who know her story and those who want to know her will see what it led to when, struck down in an instant by lightning, she found herself before the throne of God... To make a long story short, she saw herself falling and tumbling into a frightening abyss, until her feet were near the doors of hell. She began to cry out for God's mercy (at last!). Can you imagine a doctor putting his cancer patient at ease, and telling him: "Don't worry, it's not so bad, keep smoking and drinking, there's no need to stop. You don't need any special treatment." By doing this, you would be robbing the patient of any chance of survival.

False mercy is extremely serious. It consists of denying the reality of sin and its seriousness, and therefore the need for salvation. This means making the cross of Christ useless. It is a subtle trap set by the enemy because it is disguised as goodness, understanding, compassion, tolerance... A subtle imitation! Saying: "It doesn't matter, everyone does it", is murderous. It deprives us of God's mercy and forgiveness.

Thanks be to God, there are many holy priests, who radiate the love of Christ. They are recognizable in their teaching and in the confessional, when they invite their penitents to sincerely regret their sins and to trust in the infinite mercy of God, who has the heart of a father. For, as Jesus said to Saint Faustina, "If the soul were like a rotting corpse, and there were no human remedy, it is not so before God! The flames of my Mercy consume me. I am in a hurry to pour them out on souls. No sin, even an abyss of abjection, will exhaust my mercy, for the more it is drawn upon, the more it increases. It is for sinners that I have shed all my blood. Let them not fear to approach me!" (Diary § 1448)

Sin is serious if we decide to be obstinate. It is not so much the sin itself that can lose us, it is to be obstinate in sin. Sin damages man, sin is not "just human", as we mistakenly say. When we repent from our sins, God's forgiveness puts a balm of tenderness on our wounds, restores our dignity. It gives us confidence in Him and in ourselves. It strengthens us for the next battle against our evil tendencies; and very often, from one confession to another, forgiveness frees us from these tendencies and heals us. That is where the Precious Blood of Christ flows over our infected wounds and transforms them into sources of blessing.

What about those who have never heard of the God of love and are ignorant of the Christian faith? Of course, they receive very special mercy from our Father. God is love and mercy by nature! He wants to save all people and he offers everyone the same chance to be with him in Heaven. He has given everyone the freedom to choose, at the latest at the moment of death, between good and evil, between the light and the darkness, and each one will be judged according to his conscience.
