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Siblings: Peter and Maisie's Story

Maisie: Back in February, I remember Peter started looking super pale. I was concerned about him but didn't say too much about it. He was like, "I just haven't been eating as much." He was losing a lot of weight.

Then in June, I was like, "You've got to go get some blood work done before you go. Something doesn't look right with you."

He went to get some bloodwork done. The doctor called him when he was in Wisconsin so they're in their camper. He said, "Peter, your D-dimer is off the charts." That measures tumors and if you have clots.


Peter: They did two X-rays and then a CT scan. They could see a tumor. They were a smaller hospital so they weren't equipped to handle it.

Maisie: So they sent him over to the Sacred Heart of Jesus Hospital. It was on the feast day of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. It was also on the 24th of June, which is when the actual first apparition happened in Medjugorje.

Then we see this giant tumor that's in the shape of a mylar balloon heart. I'm just like, "Peter, God is doing something here."

Peter: They already did four rounds of intense chemo, and it did not shrink very much. We don't know if it's dead or if it's—

Maisie: We don't know if it's necrotic tissue. We don't know if there's cancer in there. I said, "Peter, let's start praying to Our Lady. Let's start watching Medjugorje films." I knew Our Lady was comforting for him, and I could tell he was going into a depression.



I started sending him Artie Boyle's story. Artie had a miraculous healing of metastatic kidney cancer. We watched Apparition Hill which he hadn't seen, and of course my little boy is in it.

Peter: After that, we were at her house, and I got in our vehicle with my wife and I just started sobbing. It hit me. I have two kids, but they're both adults. I was like, "I'm going to lose my family." It became very real. I just surrendered at that point.

Maisie: This all happened very quickly. It was the Feast of the Sacred Heart, and then he started having chemo at the end of July. Now in October, here we are in Medjugorje.

He finally said, "I really want to go to Medjugorje with you guys." I was like, "Let's do it."

Peter: Not initially. I just thought, "That's really big." It doesn't look real. I have to get a scan when we go back to see if it's still cancerous. They can do surgery. It's kind of like openheart surgery. I feel good now. I'm kind of at a standstill right now. For me, this trip is just spiritual. I'm not asking for a healing or anything like that. I just want to be in a peaceful place right now.



I think the diagnosis brought

me closer to God, ever since I surrendered to God. I figured, if I'm going to go, I want to be in the right place. I hadn't been to church in years. It brought me back to the Church, brought me to confession. I feel really good now. Whatever happens, I'm ready.

It's brought my wife and I closer together. She's traditionally Lutheran. She's gone to the Catholic Church with me. I think it's probably brought her closer too.

It's been more hurtful to my family. They can see that there's that chance. I think they need to be in that same place where, "If he's going to go, it's not our fault." I'm praying for peace for them too.

Update from Peter on Easter 2023: "As of now I am cancer free and my heart has been opened to the Catholic Church in a profound way. I am forever blessed."

Maisie: Right before my dad passed away in 1998 from pancreatic cancer, we really started digging into Medjugorje because he was very into Our Lady of Fatima and Lourdes. We started reading about Medjugorje together.

I found the Wayne Weible book, *Medjugorje, The Message* and I was really floored that nobody had talked to me about this before. I'm thinking, "I should know this. If this is really going on, I need to know about this."

This is when I was 16 to 18. I was really fascinated by Medjugorje, but I wasn't really listening to my parents, pretty much every day smoking weed and skipping school. I was the youngest of five kids.

My dad wanted to marry me off. He wanted to make sure I was okay. I think he felt like he needed that peace of mind. I had been dating a Jewish guy. I married him, and it was not good. We got married in a synagogue, we had a priest come, but it was not right. It was never right.

My grandmother had given us a few grand when she died. I told my mom, "I'm going to go over to this Medjugorje." It was in my heart to go there even though I was still smoking weed and doing all this stuff I shouldn't have been doing. I was still like, "This is cool. I want to find out if this is real." I told my mom, "I'm going over." She got freaked out by it. (Maisie and Peter continued on page 7)

Forgiving the unforgivable

Pascual, a little Colombian boy, was very kind and very handsome. One day, while at school, a priest made an inappropriate proposal to him. This failed, because Pascual ran away from him and thus escaped from this predator. However, his little child's heart, was so disturbed by this that he rejected all priests, the Church and even God himself. He became a hardcore atheist that day. As he was growing up, he searched for meaning in his life. He immersed himself in Eastern philosophies and practices and became a Buddhist.



One day, his best friend suggested a trip to Medjugorje, hoping to bring him back to Christ and reconcile him with the Church. He told him about the beauty of the landscape and about these 6 Croatian children who experienced extraordinary things with Heaven. Stung by curiosity, Pascual agreed. A Look Back: When Ivan Saw John Paul II in Heaven

Ivan, you returned from America in May to be present here in Medjugorje for pilgrims. How was the anniversary for you?

Each anniversary is a new memory of the years behind us. It is not only we who remember, but Our Lady herself takes us back to those early days and the years that have passed.

Choose some moments that were particularly important.

Now I am still under the influence of everything that has hap-

pened here in the past few days. The sensations I felt in those days are still very much alive in me.

When I think back to the past 24 years, I see that there have been many good things, but also bad things on the part of the communist power. But if we look at the crowds of people who come from all over the world, today we can truly be grateful to Our Lady for this spiritual renewal that she works in the Church and through which she gives birth to a new world.

This for me is the greatest visible sign. All these people become witnesses of a spiritual renewal of the Church. If we look around the church of Medjugorje, we see pilgrims who thirst for a living faith, confession and the Eucharist. This is what Our Lady has achieved with Her humility.

The Gospa

On the anniversary day you attended the apparition. Can you describe your personal experience?

It is a special moment, when she comes and is happy and serene. This time, when she came, she saw the tools they had applied to me. I think that the anniversary does not necessarily have to be the time for scientific examinations, but we have agreed.

For me, the anniversary means joy and naturalness, but this time they were not complete because I had to be careful to kneel so as not to detach the equipment that had been applied to me.

Personally I think that by now we could stop with the examinations and doubts, and therefore I say that if you have faith, there is no need for new scientific evidence continuously, because you can recognize from the outside, from the fruits, what really happens here.

John Paul II

Ivan, during the apparition you saw the Holy Father John Paul II. Can you describe what happened?

On April 2, 2005, I had already been driving for three hours on the road to New Hampshire, a state near Boston, when my wife called me to tell me that the Pope was dead. We continued driving and arrived at a church where more than a thousand people had gathered. The Rosary began at 6:00 p.m. and the apparition was at 6:40 p.m. Our Lady arrived very joyful and as always prayed for everyone and blessed all those who were in the church.

After I had recommended those present to Our Lady, the Holy Father appeared on her left. He had the appearance of a person of about 60 years old but looked much younger; he was facing Our Lady and he was smiling.

The moment I looked at the Holy Father, Our Lady also looked at Him. After some time, Our Lady looked towards me again and said these words to me:

Deen coul Look we cou he

"Dear son! Look, my son, he is with me."

The moment I saw the Holy Father lasted about 45 seconds. If I had to describe the moment when I saw the Holy Father next to Our Lady, I would say that it was as if he was wrapped in an intimate embrace of the heavenly Mother.

I never had the opportunity to meet the Holy Father during his lifetime, although the other visionaries met

him personally several times. For this reason today I am particularly grateful to Our Lady for having had the opportunity to see the Holy Father with her in Paradise.

What else do you want to tell us to conclude?

What Our Lady began here in Medjugorje on June 24, 1981, what she began in the world, does not stop, but continues. I would really like to say to all those who read these words, that all together we must accept what Our Lady desires from us so intensely.

It is nice to describe Our Lady and all the other external things that happen, but the focus is on the messages. These must be welcomed, lived and witnessed. Everything that Our Lady has planned, she will realize, even without me, Ivan, or without the parish priest Father Branko, even without Bishop Peric. For all of this journey is in God's plans and He is superior to us men.

Shocking Story of an Exorcist: The Devil Exists By Emiliano Fumaneri from lalucedimaria.it

How does an exorcist's day begin? In the case of Father Daniel Reehil, 58, exorcist of the diocese of Nashville, Tennessee and director of *Radio Maria USA*, it begins at dawn. With the alarm clock at 4:30, adoration for two hours before the Blessed Sacrament, and then Holy Mass.

At this time, where celluloid exorcists return to the cinema, it will not hurt to hear what a flesh-and-blood exorcist has to say. The priest recently related something about his experience to columnist Michael Knowles in a video almost two hours long that can be viewed on *YouTube* with over 2.5 million views in a month. A former Wall Street banker before his conversion in Medjugorje, the exorcist spares no details about the world of finance. A world that knows well, where self-centeredness, greed and thirst for power mix providing a favorable ground for the action of the devil.

Impressive are the stories of some diabolical phenomena, such as that of a man that the American priest claims to have seen levitate on the sofa or that of the possessed sister of no more than a meter and a half tall and weighing about 45 kg who was barely held in place by six men during an exorcism. That same nun he later saw climbing "like a squirrel" on a wall six meters high.

The devil of artificial intelligence

There is also the disconcerting story of some gloomy dialogues through social media such as *TikTok* or *ChatGPT* with mysterious "entities" that terrorize users with scary images. Another user, who proposed to summon demons through artificial intelligence, has instead created a sort of digital monster (soon called "AI demon", the devil of artificial intelligence) that produces very violent and macabre images of gutting and mutilations where the protagonists are often children.

Some may smile and scoff. But as Catholic apologist Tom Nash recalls in *Catholic Answer*, if it is true that "only people can be possessed by the devil," it is equally true that "inanimate objects can be controlled negatively through curses." After all, the exorcist Stephen J. Rossetti in his book *"Diary of an American Exorcist"* reports cases of demonic harassment that also occurred via text message, complete with mobile phone keys pressed by invisible hands ...

An exorcist who does teamwork

Father Daniel described several facts inexplicable from the human point of view. And he debunked several myths about the role of the exorcist who would boldly go at night to a house in the middle of a dense forest to perform exorcisms in solitude. The reality is quite different: the exorcist priest is not a loner who hunts devils. He does not act alone, but together with a team of other people, often with another priest. It is also important to have other witnesses, he explains, to eliminate the possibility of being accused of having imagined everything.

But that's not all. In fact, it can happen, although rarely, that the possessed person can lash out violently. This happened with his one physical attack: the possessed woman with the contorted movements of a snake tried to strangle him with his stole, before letting go and he collapsed to the ground when the priest invoked the name of Jesus and ordered her to stop.



The shocking "vis-à-vis" with the devil

One of the most terrifying experiences, Reehil admits, was during the process of vocational discernment at the time of entering the seminary, when he decided to stop drinking. That's when he had a sort of "close encounter" with a mysterious figure. As soon as he left the church one day, around noon, he said he noticed a man well dressed in all respects staring at him insistently. A rather unusual thing in New York. That same man then approached him as he walked to the office, grabbed his arm and said, "Let's go get a drink." At that moment, Father Daniel explains that he felt a shiver run through his body and told him: "Get away from me!" Then he remembers immediately changing direction and heading towards his apartment. Once he returned, the doors closed behind him. And looking out the window he still saw that disturbing figure. And he was just laughing at him.

> As soon as he saw him leave, he says, he went to tell his spiritual director, an old Polish priest, about the face-to-face with that obscure individual. And from him, he had confirmation that that presence was indeed demonic. It was one of the two times, confesses the exorcist, in which the devil presented himself to him "in person". The same figure appeared to him on a beach in Miami, where he had gone to visit his former co-workers, instructing him on that occasion to move away from his territory.

Transgenderism and abortion

Another theme strongly attended to by the devil is that of the sexual difference between men and women: Satan hates the opportunity granted to man and woman to cooperate with God in the work of creation and thereby generating new lives. A power precluded to him, who can create nothing. From here originates the whole transgenderism wave, which has a clear sulfurous mark. Scripture shows very well that "only God assigns gender," Father Dan emphasizes. "Male and female God created them," we read in Genesis. The claim to decide one's own sex is therefore equivalent to wanting to play the part of God, a satanic temptation par excellence.

Another strong point of contention: Satan's hatred for unborn life. There is also the fact that today, the womb has become one of the most dangerous places in the world for an unborn child. Let us imagine how such a situation can be viewed by Heaven. Shocking then what the exorcist reveals in this regard: that is, the existence of people dedicated to magic and witchcraft willing to pay for abortions and then to attend during the execution of the abortion and practice magical rites. Thus, we are in the presence, he explains, of an authentic "sacrifice to the devil".

Satan's hatred of Mary

We will see on another occasion what advice Father Daniel gives to protect oneself from diabolical pitfalls. For now, since we are on a web site that aims to spread the light of Mary, it seems to me useful to point out that among the first protections against the devil the priest mentions the "deep love for Our Lady". Few things irritate and scandalize Satan more than the fact that it is Mary who crushes the serpent's head. Because, explains the Nashville exorcist, "It is one thing to be crushed by God, because everyone knows that God is God. But being crushed by a tiny, little Jewish woman brings a tremendous scandal and insult to the devil, from which he will never recover."



She felt like she had to come with me because she was scared. We came in 2000. I saw Fr. Slavko and then I went home and he died right when we got home in November of 2000. He died at the top of Cross mountain after leading pilgrims in the Way of the Cross. I saw him in the flesh here. He gave a talk to us.

We saw Vicka over at her place down the street giving kisses, and she actually blessed me. We got to see Marija in an apparition. I climbed Mount Križevac. I did everything. I just knew this was a special place, and this really is as special as they say it is.

The seed was planted. It grew and grew and grew when I got home. My husband was doing a lot of drugs and I didn't want to be in that lifestyle anymore. It was almost immediate. I didn't want to live that life anymore. What I experienced was so beautiful and then I came home to that. It was very quickly from light to dark.

It wasn't like anything earth-shattering happened to me here. I didn't see the sun spin. It was just that feeling that this was a powerful place and I really believe that this is real. If this is real, then I really want to change who I am. I really want to change what's going on in my life. But I always had a good foundation, thanks be to God. I have a good family.

I love Our Lady, and slowly it just grew and grew. I became very open with how much I love Her. People always just knew that about me. Three years later I asked for a divorce. I went to school to be a nurse. I was by myself for a while. I was like, "I need to figure out what I really want now and wait for the right person." I worked with people with traumatic brain injuries.

Since then, I have always felt very strong and tight with Mary. I really just needed Her. I didn't feel like I needed to be with a guy. It was good. When you feel like that, then the right person comes along usually. I met my husband. He was absolutely crazy about me, and I was crazy about him. It was magical. He was Catholic. That was a prerequisite. We have three beautiful children.

It's a real blessing to be here with my brothers. It's been so fun. They're excellent brothers. A grace for me personally would be climbing the mountain and really feeling at the top of that mountain that I needed to surrender this whole thing over to God. My brother, Peter, has this tumor and as a nurse, I have been, with his wife who is also a nurse, fighting for him to save him. It's been really hard on us. Every single person I see at work I ask to pray for him. It's been like my full time job to try to save him. That's a lot of pressure. It's not my responsibility, but he's my brother, and I love him.
