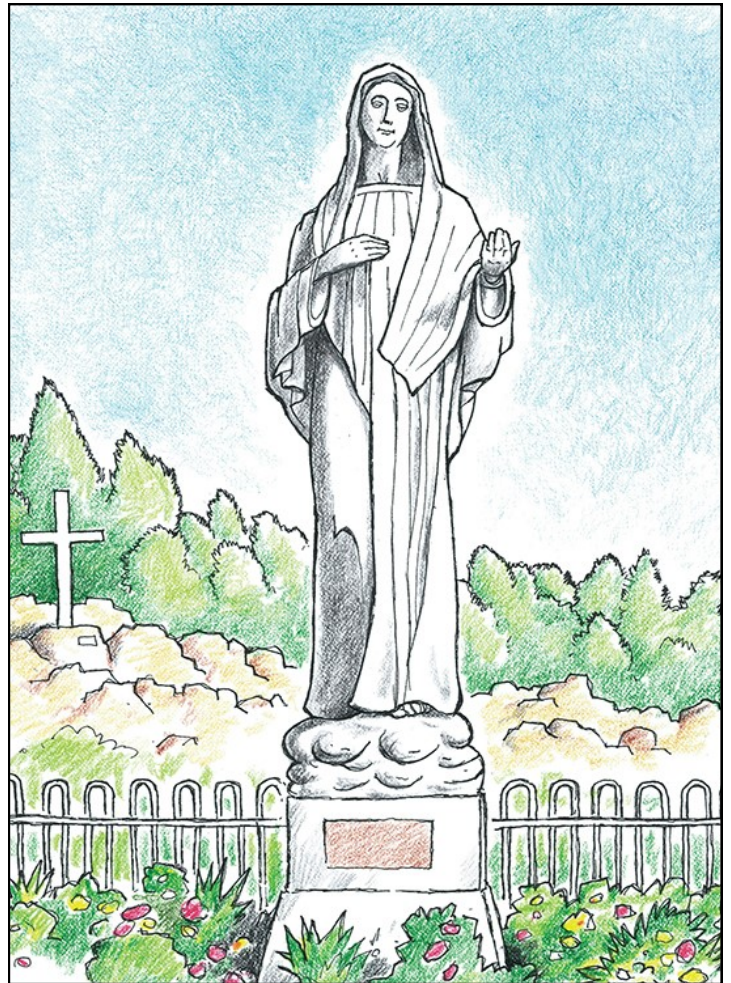

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Apostles of Love

“My motherly heart suffers tremendously...too many are walking to eternal perdition.”

I have always been struck by the great words Jesus spoke in St. John's Gospel: “A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another” (John 13:34-35).

During a recent visit to Medjugorje, this Jesus commandment came back to life for me. Particularly, of course, through the motherly messages Our Lady is constantly giving to our shattered humanity. Leafing through the messages, I was really impressed about the many times she speaks of the importance of being apostles of love. If we want to be sincere, we have to admit that love is sorely needed nowadays. Suffice to look at the disastrous situations that occur internationally, nationally, and especially, in our personal lives.

In a message given to one of the visionaries, Mirjana Sol-do, on March 2nd, 2005, Our Lady said: ***“Dear children, do the same as I do. Come, share love and with your own example give my Son to everyone.”*** Is this not a clear-cut reminder of Jesus' word in John 13:34-35 in which He tells us that the others will recognize that you and I are his disciples when we love one another?

In her messages, Our Lady emphasizes that God's love is much needed, first and foremost in our families. In a message given on the 25th of June 2005, she said: ***“Dear children. Today I thank you for every sacrifice that you have offered for my intentions. I call you, little children, to be my apostles of peace and love in your families and in the world. Pray that the Holy Spirit will enlighten and lead you on the way of holiness. I am with you and bless you all with my motherly blessing. Thank you for having responded to my call.”***

The love which fills the heart of Jesus is the same love which imbues the heart of His and Our Mother Mary. The Gospa's heart is greatly pained when it sees people indulge in modern idolatry. In other words, when they put what is human before what comes from God himself. No wonder then that in that apparition Our Lady was very sad. That is why the Gospa is encouraging you and me that, through the witness of our lives, we help these people to put God first in their lives. It is solely by putting God first that their lives are ordered in God's saving and sanctifying grace.

In her March 2nd, 2011 message for the world, given to Mirjana, She says: ***“Dear children, my motherly heart suffers tremendously as I look at my children who persistently put what is human before what is of God. I see my children who, despite everything that surrounds them and despite all the signs that are sent to them, think that they can walk without my Son. They cannot! They are walking to eternal perdition. That is why I am gathering you, who are ready to open your heart to me, you who are ready to be apostles of my love, to help me; so that by living God's love you may be an example***

Ivan Speaks on Our Lady's Messages of Peace

On May 22nd, 2021, speaking to a crowd of faithful, priests and bishops present in Medjugorje, Ivan Dragic once again witnessed the message of the Queen of Peace saying that the most important thing for Our Lady is peace. All the messages on the conversion of love towards others are a way to induce the faithful to undertake the journey desired for them by Jesus Christ and therefore to reach eternal bliss, but they are also things we can do through which we can help make peace among men. Our Lady's desire is to see each of us live in peace

The visionary began the conference by saying that the messages shared by Our Lady were numerous. To talk about every message, would take days, but what concerned Ivan is to transmit the most important desire of the Queen of Peace, that is the achievement of peace between men and the end of every conflict: “Our Lady comes to us as our Mother and says: ***‘Dear children, I come to you because I want to help you. I come to you because My Son Jesus sends me.’*** Then she says three times: ***‘Peace, peace, only peace’***. ***‘Dear children, peace must reign among men and God and among men themselves’***. From these first messages we notice what is the greatest desire of Our Lady. It is peace.”

This desire for peace, continues Ivan, comes because for the Madonna there are no differences between men, nor reasons for entering into conflict. All peoples are equal and all people are her children. The path to peace, however, is undermined by the crisis of faith that is experienced in this period and which presages a future society without God.

If this happened, says Our Lady, there will never be peace among peoples, never a future society in which everything is finally fair and just. In one of the messages delivered to Ivan, in fact, he says: ***“Dear children, this humanity desires to enter the future without God. Dear children, today prayer has disappeared from your families”***. But a future without God is a future without inner peace and consequently a future of war. In fact, in another message Our Lady says: ***“Dear children, if there is no peace in the heart of man, if man is not at peace with himself, if there is no peace in the family, dear children, there cannot be peace in the world.”***

Nancy's journey

Nancy is only 20 years old, but she has certainly been through a lot! By the age of 12, she was a typical rebellious teenager. Her parents then tried to convey at least a little bit of faith to their daughter... all in vain. However, one day... As Nancy tells it, "I thought that by getting priests out of my life, I would be more authentic with God. However, as I moved away from the priests, I distanced myself from the Lord himself by abandoning the Sacraments.

When I began my journey with God after my conversion at the age of 14, I had not yet realized how much I hated priests. During Mass, I always remained at the back of the



church. I only went to confession when strictly necessary, and I never held my tongue when I had the opportunity to denigrate priests. The few disappointments I experienced and the fear of looking inside myself so completely discredited priests in my eyes that I did not consider them as men in their own right, but rather as losers, people who were incoherent, etc.

Why are you persecuting me? One day I was attending Mass in a shrine dedicated to St. Anthony

of Padua, who most certainly interceded for me. A friend of mine asked me to stand by her side to give her some support while she read the psalm from the ambo, because she was anxious, feeling this task was almost impossible for her to achieve. I immediately agreed, and found myself in the front row to follow the Mass. I was very embarrassed, but I tried to behave normally. It worked until the moment of the Consecration. At that moment, the priest who was celebrating Mass and whom I had always known, seemed to have become another person: his face and his vestment were completely transfigured. He was smiling at me and I

heard him say to me inwardly, "Why are you persecuting me?" Immediately I thought of St. Paul and his experience on the road to Damascus. I began to weep, but they were tears of sorrow for hurting Jesus with my hatred of priests. At the same time, they were tears of joy, for I understood that this smile invited me not only to stop speaking ill of priests, but also to care for Jesus who is present in them.

This experience shook me and made me understand that Jesus loves His priests just as they are, so much so that He comes down to the altar through a simple gesture, a simple word on their part, even if they have sinned. This taught me to love them in turn, because only love can make them better. Hatred, on the other hand, often contributes to making them worse. To hate is to curse, and to wish for an evil that sometimes comes true. On the other hand, to love is to bless and draw upon them graces from God. This is what priests need in order to become saints!

I have forgiven the priests who have disappointed me, and I have forgiven myself for refusing to love them in the past. By forgiving them, I received much more than I lost, and so did they. I was trying to help the poor, and I cared about the Third World, but I did not notice another great poverty, that of abandoned, ridiculed and humiliated priests.

I would like to convey one last very important message: let us support our priests, because their holiness also depends on us; they need our prayers and our love, the very love that God wants to give us through them."

Note: I know Nancy well, and I would like to add that, on that blessed day, she truly received a great mission of prayer and intercession for priests. Now, she doesn't waste a single opportunity to help them the best she can, with whatever resources she has. She feels that for her, this has become a true calling from Heaven, a vocation for her life, and one which she is fulfilling well!

A Look Back at the Early Days: Our Lady Chose a Parish

St. James parish was clearly chosen by Our Lady. The entire parish was chosen and not just the six visionaries. This is extraordinary! A whole parish—called by the Lord through Our Lady! And what a call they have had. In the early years, the parish existed in a hostile environment, under a communist regime. They were penalized for being Catholic. Their pastor was put in prison, and they were hounded by the police. You would think this would not be an ideal place for Our Lady to come. But as we see, it was the best place for Her to appear. The people of Medjugorje knew how to be faithful to God. They had learned it over 500 years of Turkish rule, and then war and communism.

During our visit to Medjugorje for the 30th anniversary, our guide Ivanka Petrovic, gave a stirring talk to us about the history of Medjugorje, I want to quote the second part of her talk now, because she shares about the first days of the apparitions from the perspective of the parish, the parish Our Lady picked to be Her home:

“In 1981, Medjugorje was a poor village. The name of Medjugorje was not written on any maps. People who lived 20 kilometers away didn't know where Medjugorje was. There was no traffic sign that would direct you to Medjugorje. There was only one telephone line, but it didn't work. It was strange. Fr. Jozo Zovko was the pastor in Medjugorje. But on that day, June 24th, 1981, he was not in the town. He was leading a spiritual retreat in Zagreb and the priests at the parish of St. James couldn't inform him of what was happening because the phone didn't work. They thought the story of the children might last a day or two, but they didn't want to disturb his spiritual retreat.

“On the way home from Zagreb to Medjugorje, Fr. Jozo stopped in a hospital to visit his mother, and this is where he met a lady who was a little mentally ill, and she was yelling at him: Father, what are you doing here? Don't you know that Our Lady is appearing in Medjugorje?” He thought the poor lady was really sick and losing her mind. He didn't know what was going on in his parish.

“He came to the parish and heard the same story from the priest. But you know, Fr. Jozo was just a new pastor. From the beginning, he had started evangelizing the parish of Medjugorje, trying to bring the Charismatic Movement to the parish, trying to make the people come more often to pray the Rosary. But when he would ask the children what they would rather do—pray or play— they would always chose to play.

They were not particularly holy children. Fr. Jozo tried to convince them to come to church, but there was not much response. So, he was not open to the story; he thought the communists were behind the story to discredit the church. On the other hand, the communists thought that Fr. Jozo was behind it. They thought he would start the story, get the attention of 5000 people, and start a revolution against the communists.

So, the poor children, they didn't have support from the priests, or from the government or from their parents or anybody. It was a very difficult time for all of them.

“So finally, when the police heard about all these events, they were standing at the bottom of the hill. They didn't allow anyone to go up the hill. And then the children were running through the fields running to the church. And the police were chasing them. Fr. Jozo was alone in the church, praying. He was trying to convince the villagers to come to the church and pray. He said, ‘God is in the church, not on the mountain.’ He was in the church, praying, trying to read the Bible, but he heard a very special soft voice that said to him, ‘Open the door and protect the children.’ He opened the door and saw the visionaries running toward him. That was the first contact of Fr. Jozo with the children. He still didn't believe, but he felt sympathy for the children. So, he opened the door and protected the children, but not only the children, there were thousands of people with them. He didn't know what to do,

how to help them. So, he said, ‘Let's pray a Rosary.’ After the first Rosary, the children said, ‘Father we want to pray another one.’ This was a big shock for Father! These children want to pray! So, they prayed a second Rosary. During that second Rosary, the Blessed Mother appeared; it was twenty minutes before seven. Then they said that the Holy Mother requested Holy Mass and seven Our Fathers, seven Hail Marys and seven Glory Be's.

“Fr. Jozo was under very heavy pressure from the government. He didn't believe in the apparitions at first. He thought if he started Holy Mass, God would take care of all this.

So, he celebrated the Mass, and after the Mass, they began the prayer of the seven Our Fathers, Hail Marys, and Glory Be's. During that prayer, the Blessed Mother appeared to him. From that moment on, he changed and started supporting the children. But because of the beautiful homilies he gave, especially a homily on Confession, about someone who lives in the darkness of sin for 40 years and found the light in Medjugorje, Father was arrested. The communists thought he was criticizing them and that the 40 years of darkness was his way of describing the 40 years of communism, from 1941 to 1981.

“Fr. Jozo was arrested, and they thought that when they put him in prison, the apparitions would stop. But you see that after 40 years the apparitions are still taking place. I hope this history will help you to understand why Medjugorje was chosen by Heaven and why Our Lady chose to appear here.

We see from this account that Our Lady began the evening program right away, by sending the children to the church and preparing Fr. Jozo to protect them, and then requesting Holy Mass. That evening Mass and evening recitation of the Rosary has become a dynamo of prayer for the entire world! Thank you St. James parish, for answering Our Lady's call and opening your doors to the entire world and reminding the world how to pray!



One of the Early Healings in Medjugorje; the Case of Damir Coric

Damir Coric, who suffered from internal hydrocephaly, had undergone three drainage operations in the Zagreb Surgical Clinic. Each time the operation had resulted in a cerebral hemorrhage which had necessitated further surgery. The likelihood of more hemorrhages was great, and Damir's prognosis was grim in the extreme. Meanwhile, he had lost a great deal of weight and was very weak. At Medjugorje, during the summer of 1981, Vicka prayed for him. Damir Coric was cured – and rapidly regained his former weight and strength.

In 1979, when I was in my third year of high school I began to feel weak. I felt it first in my legs. I couldn't lift them, but almost had to drag them along below my body in order to walk. Actually though, I felt no pain; but walking was very difficult. It got harder every day. My family told me over and over that I had to do something about it, and finally my mother talked me into going to a doctor.

After the examination, they called my mother and told her that they had found something in my head. Immediately they sent me to Zagreb. I stayed in Zagreb for three weeks and then went home but returned in August for my first operation. I had five operations and after the fifth they told my parents to take me home. I was in very bad condition. I couldn't walk. My parents had to hold me up. My mother said I was like a dead man. Those who visited could not recognize me.



I could do nothing for myself. I couldn't even take a sip of water through a straw. My mother had to prop me up and would try to feed me. The doctors said they could do no more for me. They said I might live a short time or might die tomorrow. But my mother never gave up hope. She kept hoping that God would help me.

My mother heard about Medjugorje from some young people, some girls who were going there. She asked them to please bring her some flowers or dirt from that place— anything. The girls brought some soil from Medjugorje and my mother mixed the soil with water and bathed me with it— two or three times. She used just a small amount because she was trying to make it last. Sometimes she washed only my head with it. Then my mother went to Medjugorje and she gathered some wild flowers that were growing on the hill where Our Lady appeared and she put them in water and washed me with this water. She put all of her heart and her soul into what she was doing; she felt she was bringing a blessing from Medjugorje— that God and the Blessed Virgin would help us.

Finally they took me to Medjugorje. My Mother had decided: "We're going to Medjugorje, and we'll accept any outcome that God sees fit to give us." There was a very large crowd on the hill. When they brought me to the visionaries, I felt nothing at all. Nothing had changed. But then they took me a second time and when they took me the second time, one of the girls— I later learned it was Vicka— prayed over me, she prayed to God for me. At once, something... all that heaviness left me and I immediately felt better.

With us was one of my godmothers. I did not want to say anything in front of her. After we had dropped my godmother off at the gas station, after she got out of the car, I said: "Mother, I did not want to say anything in front of godmother, but when Vicka prayed to God for me, I felt something. A lightness-as if a healing had started working in me. It was as if a heaviness was leaving me."

I can't describe it but I felt reborn again. I felt reborn both in my soul and my body. After that I have not had any after effects, any traces of the illness. Well, sometimes, I catch a cold but nothing from the condition that had so weakened me.

The doctors had told my mother to never expect anything from me. But my strength returned and I was able to work normally. I was able to dig as well as my father and brother, to dig gravel two meters deep.

I was a church goer before my illness, but church was not an important part of my life. But after the healing in Medjugorje, through the power of God, now I go to church every time I can. I would like to tell everyone that faith can save every person. I thank God and I thank the Mother of God!

this opportunity to surrender everything into her motherly hands, and give ourselves to her in everything. If we truly belong to her, she too will belong to us, with all the treasures of her own that are beyond imagination.

Among the most beautiful consecrations to Mary, is that of Father Maximilian Kolbe. We need to consecrate ourselves to Mary now more than ever, in circumstances where the flood of evil has swept over the world, and darkened the consciences of so many. Despite Mary's luminous schooling for 40 years, it is distorting the decision making of so many and provoking many bad choices. However, let us remember her promise: **"If you are mine, you will win, for your refuge will be the Heart of my Son Jesus."** Heaven today is looking for winners!

A promising "interlude"!

The visionary, Mirjana, gave us this significant image: Often, during a move, the place we leave becomes complete chaos, we don't know where to set foot, we wonder what is stored in which box, the furniture is in a different place ... In short, you can easily become discouraged by the pervasive disorder. But once the move is done, then everything is harmoniously set in its place, clean and welcoming. And then it feels good to live in this new home. Mirjana (who received her 10 secrets about the future of the world), explains that we are in the phase of the greatest disorder, but that it is not going to last!

Our Holy Mother also talks about future generations! She does see the suffering, but she sees much beyond! I wondered why, in older messages, she spoke to us in the future tense: **"I will help you, I will comfort you, I will protect you, I will show you the way, I will not abandon you"**, etc. Now I understand! She saw in advance the ordeal we are experiencing today, and she wanted to prepare us to hold on to divine peace in the midst of suffering and uncertainty. We are at a critical crossroads in human history!

That is why, instead of wasting time making endless lists of what is wrong, let us raise our eyes and meet the gaze of Mary and that of her Son. This interchange of glances is an outpouring of the Holy Spirit! A breath of the Pentecost! From whom will salvation come? Certainly not from human beings who are powerless to save themselves. We know and believe that this difficult interlude in our history will give way to the Triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary and that of her Son. But much of what must happen depends on us, on how we respond to Mary's repeated invitations!

At Gethsemane, Jesus told those who came to arrest him, "This is your hour and the power of darkness." That is what is happening today! Our society arrested Jesus and wants to get rid of Him. Jesus also quoted to his apostles this word from the Bible (Matt 26:31) "I will strike the shepherd and the sheep of the flock will be scattered." What should we do then? Walk humbly and faithfully with Mary, in the light of the Gospel, repeating Christ's teaching, especially His splendid commandment of love, being ready to bear witness to Him even to the point of blood if necessary... These witnesses, this "little remnant" that the Gospa calls **"Apostles of my love,"** will bring us to The New Time, that time of peace that Mary prophesied in the messages, which her Heart is looking forward to.

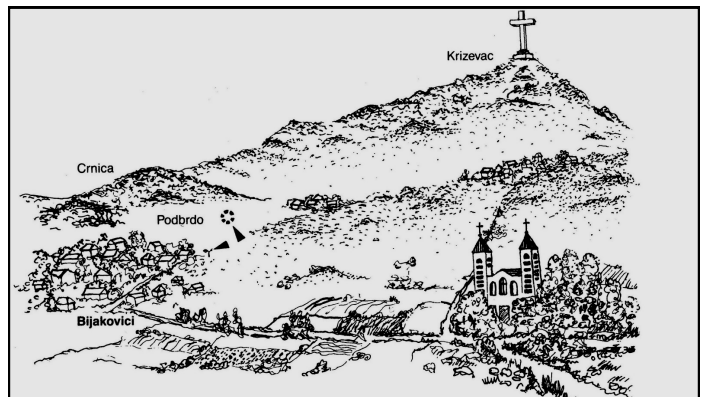

How many times has Our Lady called us in these forty years and told us: **"Children, you are chosen to be witnesses of peace and joy"**. We know that these words come from a pure heart, a heart of peace, a heart of calm, a heart that never tires. Dear friends, every month Our Lady gives us a message with which she wants to guide us, which is like a sign on the road to show us the right direction.

You know, when we drive a car, there are these signs that show us the way, where we are to go. If we stopped at the sign, if we stayed at the sign, we would never reach the goal, the destination, the place where we must go. So the sign has the meaning of helping us, to prevent us from getting lost in order to guide to a place and in a similar way, with the messages of Our Lady, she wishes to guide us, to carry us forward and it is we who must decide whether we want to follow the messages or not.

For almost forty years Our Lady has spoken to us and she speaks to our hearts: **"Pray dear children"**. A thousand and a thousand times she has said these words: **May prayer be a joyful encounter with the Savior**. The fruit of prayer is love, this love that we seek and to which we aspire.

In the times in which we live we encounter less and less love in human relationships. There is more and more jealousy and chatter, ways to exploit others. And why is prayer so difficult? "Dear children, I am with you and I thank God for each one of you who seriously accepted the call to prayer. I pray for all of you and intercede before my son for each of you. I pray for your perseverance and for your abandonment. Thank you dear children for having responded to my call once again today."

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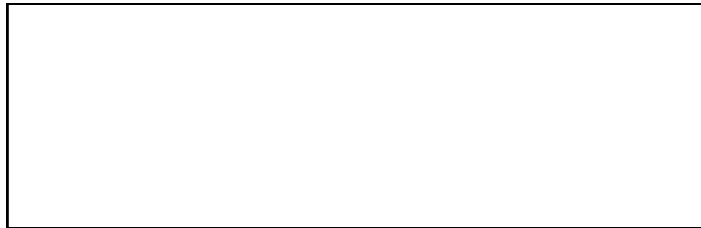
