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## Consecration of the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus



### ***Why Consecrate America to the Sacred Heart?***

On November 11, the bishops of the United States voted to consecrate this nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The consecration will take place in 2026 to celebrate America's semiquincentennial, that is, the two hundred and fiftieth anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. What does this mean? Why consecrate the nation to the Sacred Heart?

Devotion to the Sacred Heart has developed over the centuries following the experiences of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and the apparitions she witnessed in the seventeenth century. Popes have lauded the practice of consecration of the self, home, and even whole nations to the Sacred Heart. In his encyclical instituting the Solemnity of Christ the King, Pope Pius XI, drawing on the teaching of Pope Leo XIII, commended the "pious custom" of consecrating the nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus as a way to recognize the kingship of Christ. By celebrating this important national anniversary with this devotion, we have the opportunity to encourage all Catholics to honor our Lord and to "infuse the spirit of the Gospel into various communities and departments of life."

With his encyclical, *Dilexit Nos*, Pope Francis brought devotion to the Sacred Heart to the forefront of our contemporary Catholic life and culture. He noted: "In contemplating the pierced heart of the Lord, who 'took our infirmities and bore our diseases,' we too are inspired to be more attentive to the sufferings and needs of others and confirmed in our efforts to share in his work of liberation as instruments for the spread of his love. As we meditate on Christ's self-offering for the sake of all, we are naturally led to ask why we too should not be ready to give our lives for others." In *Dilexi Te*, Pope Leo invited us to contemplate Christ's love, which moves us out on our mission to attend to our sisters and brothers suffering in the world today, particularly in our care for poor and vulnerable people. As we

reflect with gratitude on the blessings God has bestowed on our country, our devotion to the Sacred Heart demands that we consider how we might foster truth, justice, and charity in American life. We are called to bring our faith into the actions we take and the lives we lead in our communities. We celebrate the ways the Church has contributed to a more just world, and we invite all in our society to see the face of Christ reflected in each sister and brother. We welcome God's "kingdom of justice, fraternity and solidarity," remembering that "God has a special place in his heart for those who are discriminated against and oppressed, and he asks us, his Church, to make a decisive and radical choice in favor of the weakest." This anniversary and consecration will be a great opportunity to promote the beautiful devotion to the Sacred Heart and to encourage the laity to offer their lives in service to God and their country.

## From the Diary of Sister Emmanuel

On April 25th, 2025, the visionary, Marija received the following monthly message:

***Dear children, I am praying for you and encourage you to a new life, a life in joy and prayer. May the Holy Spirit fill you, little children, with joy so that you may be like a spring of pure and drinkable water; that you, little children, may be in God and with God missionaries of love and peace. Your life is short here on earth and that is why I am with you to lead you towards Heaven. Thank you for responding to my call.*** (With ecclesiastical approval)

### *The power of God and man's gratitude*

Peppe owns a large seafood restaurant in Naples, near the sea. He is 54 years old, married, and a father. Everything was going well for him until he was greatly afflicted: two years ago, he was diagnosed with a very rare and virtually incurable cancer, which spread throughout his entire body. For two years, he suffered from severe bleeding from his mouth.

The diagnosis was very clear: stage IV T-cell lymphoma, which is potentially curable only after intensive chemotherapy. He came to Medjugorje and prayed for his recovery. Upon his return, he found that the lymphoma had shrunk and that he had a 99% chance of it being cured.



He went back to Medjugorje to thank Our Lady. The visionary, Marija, gave him a little cross blessed by Our Lady during an apparition. He immediately put it around his neck. A little later, in his sleep, he dreamt that the Blessed Mother accompanied him to the Blue Cross with ten doctors ready to operate on him. She told him: "Your chemo will feel like water to you."

Indeed, throughout his treatment, he felt nothing, while other patients endured terrible suffering accompanied by side effects such as hair loss. He underwent a PET scan, (a molecular imaging method to detect the spread of lymphoma), and it was discovered that it had disappeared. He was cured! He then promised Our Lady that he would return to Medjugorje every year to thank her.

Medjugorje is certainly a place of healing and grace, but not everyone is healed here. Those who come, however, find meaning in their lives and leave with this gift of Our Lady who is a compassionate Mother to her children who are suffering. She speaks to us clearly, guiding us through today's trials. Without her we cannot make it, and she leads us to Jesus, who alone is our future.

The Blessed Mother tells us in Medjugorje that "the future of humanity is at a crossroads." It is a call to choose a direction:

***"Modern man does not want God. That is why mankind is heading to perdition. You, little children, are my hope... Be prayer and witness peace in your surroundings, and be people of peace."*** (January 25, 2023)

Before the Balkan War, she said: ***"I invite you to pray with the heart in order that your prayer may be a conversation with God. I desire each one of you to dedicate more time to God. Satan is strong and wants to destroy and deceive you in many ways. Therefore, dear children, pray every day that your life will be good for yourselves and for all those you meet. I am with you and I am protecting you even though Satan wishes to destroy my plans and to hinder the desires which the Heavenly Father wants to realize here."*** (September 25, 1990)

### *Mary's extraordinary Motherhood.*

After the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven, Mary remained on earth. The Gospel tells us nothing of these years. Some saints and mystics received revelations about them and unveiled profound aspects of her motherhood.

Blessed Conchita Cabrera of Mexico (1862-1937) was shown the solitude of Mary in her last years on earth. Mary experienced an inner martyrdom of which very few are aware. Wholly turned toward her Lord and Master, she continued to share in the sufferings of the Passion, offering them up for the growth of the Church. These meditations can only help us, especially in this month of May, to enter more deeply into the mystery of Mary and to love her more.

Jesus revealed to Conchita:

***"At the foot of the Cross, all her children were born. My death gave them life in the heart of My Mother. But before her death She had to manifest this maternity on earth, gaining, by the sufferings of My absence, an infinitude of graces present and future for her children. Her title of Mother of mankind, Mary won by the martyrdom of her solitude after My death. Has the world been aware of this? Does it appreciate it and is it grateful for it?"***

***The time has come when the children should show they are real children, showing their veneration for this heart broken by this subtle and most painful martyrdom, lived through for the sake of their own happiness. There, Mary gained graces for each and every man. It is time for her to be***

## Atheism and Diabolical Possession

Today's world has truly rejected faith and the Cross. What characterizes our time is not only the denial of the existence of God and the supernatural, as modernism professes. It is not enough to say that the devil does nothing, has no power, because he does not exist, as atheists claim. Having denied God and distanced themselves from Him, atheists are more exposed to the attacks of the devil. With atheists, the devil does not show himself immediately, he gradually drags them into evil without them realizing it. When he has immobilized them spiritually with his poison, the devil shows himself as a master who has now enslaved them. If there is someone who has to fear the devil, then, it is precisely those who do not believe in him, who deny his existence.

Even those who believe in God are attacked by the devil but faith is a great shield that defends against the fiery darts of the evil one. The devil flees from the advance of Jesus who is the Kingdom of God personified; as He advances, the demons flee. The devil is like darkness that dissipates in the face of light, it is evil that is rejected and driven back by good. When there is no light, darkness expands, when good is missing, evil expands. Those who live in atheism believe that they have liquidated the problem by denying the existence of God and the devil; in reality, as we well know, God exists and so does the devil. Atheists, as such, are more exposed to the snares of the devil than believers.

The danger of our world is the denial of the existence of God and the devil precisely because, in reality, Satan reigns, he reaps souls. The world without God is under the power of the devil. This reality concerns the world in general and Our Lady said it clearly recently: "**Satan reigns**" (Message of 25 March 2020), recalling the Message of 1 January 2001: "**Satan is loosed from his chains**". According to the description given by the Queen of Peace, we are in the historical era in which the prophecy of the Apocalypse occurred when she describes Satan freed from his chains. This is happening at a time of secularization of the world; the secular world has eliminated the supernatural and therefore has eliminated both God and the devil. Satan has succeeded in his intent because, if there is no faith in God in our hearts, Satan reigns.

It is paradoxical what is happening. Precisely in a historical phase of great secularization in which the world denies the existence of God and reduces the devil to a symbol of evil, what is striking is that the devil reigns supreme in hearts. Our Lady has given several Messages in which she evokes the presence of Satan who wants hatred, war, longing to take possession of as many souls as possible to lead them to perdition. Our Lady often speaks in her messages of the presence of the devil precisely because we have entered the phase of generalized atheism, theorized by modern materialist and evolutionist ideologies. There

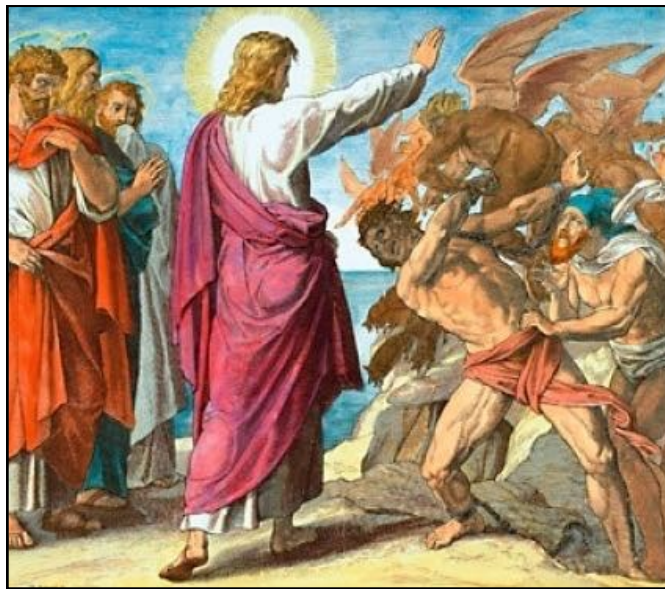
is a sort of slide towards evil and towards Satan, who shapes us in his image, obscures our minds, takes away the supernatural, takes possession of our person through sin and clouds all the faculties of the soul, obscures our ability to reason and to elevate our minds until we reach the awareness of God's presence. The devil erases the idea of God that He is intimate in the mind of every man and then works in hearts by unhinging them one by one. Satan enters hearts with arrogance and sows hatred, just look around. The world denies Satan but the world is at the mercy of Satan's hatred.

Through the darkening of the mind and the pollution of the heart, Satan takes possession of a person and makes him his slave through sin, vice, and the denial of the existence of God. As a result, the very faculties of the soul are perverted. The God-oriented mind changes direction and orients itself only to material things, the heart that desires God in itself becomes a slave to the pleasures of this world. The devil thus manages to take possession of people, leading them towards a total closure towards the supernatural which becomes, consequently, final impenitence.

Just as there is a path of gradual holiness that goes forward through the practice of virtue, so there is a path of perversion towards the final impenitence through which the devil enslaves us. The devil dulls the mind, makes it incapable of supernatural reasoning and closes the heart with evil, with vices, with selfishness, with wickedness, with pride.

Slowly, then, Satan permeates us with himself and transforms us into his image. When we reach this level, what happens is that Satan manifests himself and also asks for worship, adoration. These are the infernal abysses of the path of perversion. Just as there is a path of holiness under the grace of the Holy Spirit, there is a path of perversion in which the devil enslaves us and makes us in his image to the point of leading us to the worship and adoration of the accursed. It then happens that one becomes Satan's lieutenant, as Judas had become.

The devil works tirelessly. Just as the Holy Spirit transforms us into Christ through a path of holiness and perfection, so Satan takes possession of us and leads us on the path of perversion until he drags us into a state of final impenitence through which we already experience hell here on this earth. Let us make a brief examination of conscience and ask ourselves on which path we are. If we realize that we are on the path of evil, we need to make a good U-turn and get back on the right path. Let us not postpone conversion. Let us approach the Sacrament of Confession, let us open our hearts to God, let us ask Him for forgiveness. Let us return to God, let us return to the way of Salvation. Let us return to Christ.



# Professional Baseball Player Carlos Carrasco in Medjugorje

**Karry:** Well, Carlos had a game in Miami, I'm going with the kids, and I invited a friend. She's very Catholic. She has a show called Raices. Her story was nominated for an Emmy. . She helps Venezuelans who arrive here. She came to the stadium. We were in a suite, several bottles of wine, and she drank wine like water. I had just gotten back from Dubai, Turkey, Istanbul, Cappadocia, and she said, "You were so close to the Virgin!"

"What Virgin?" I said. She talked so much, she was already tipsy. She kept talking and talking, and I was like, "Yeah, yeah, sure." Then she takes off a rosary that she has in her hand... and she said, "Give this to Carlos. I've tried to go to this place many times," and she starts talking about the apparitions of Our Lady in Medjugorje. To this day I can't pronounce it: Medruj... Medrugor... Medrujo. That's as far as I got. She kept talking about the Virgin, she called her "the Gospa,"

I was half-listening. She gave me her rosary and said, "Give this to Carlos." I said, "Okay, perfect." She said, "I want you to know her story. I'll give you a book." A week later, the book arrived at my house "*My Heart Will Triumph*" by Mirjana. She wrote, "She's waiting for you. Not everyone can go to her — only those who receive the invitation."

I thought, "She's crazy." I didn't pay attention. She said, "She's not inviting Carlos — she's inviting you." I said, "Yeah, yeah, sure, I'll go." I was tipsy, so I just said yes to be polite. The book stayed in my house for months. I never read it. One day I went to see Carlos in New York, opened the drawer looking for something, and found the book. "Oh, I'll take it," I said. On the plane, I started reading it. From that day, I couldn't stop. I couldn't close it. It didn't even talk about the Virgin yet — it was about the persecution of the children. That's what hooked me. The way it was written — so fast-paced — it just pulled me in.

I finished it in one day. Then the next day, I read it again. Then a third day — again. I spent a whole month reading it over and over. I was fascinated by the war, her brother, her worries...

I kept explaining everything to Carlos. He wouldn't listen. He'd start reading and fall asleep. So I was like my friend now, the one I thought was crazy when she told me! That's how I was. I would talk to him, and he thought I was crazy.

So we decided to make the trip. We take a couples' trip every year, just us two. This time, for the first time, he didn't know where we were going. I texted my friend, "Thank you for the book — it's the best thing I've ever read." She said, "She wants you to go. She insists. It's been months." That was around late September or early October. She said, "She's inviting you." And I said, "You know what? I'm going." It was 10:30 p.m. I hung up and told my mother-in-law, "I need to see the Virgin. I don't know who she is or what she's called, but I have to go." I called the travel agent: "I need you to include this place in our itinerary." She said, "You're crazy, everything's already booked, the tickets are already bought!" I said, "No, make it happen."

Two hours later, at 1 a.m., she called back: "Okay, you'll land in Dubrovnik. From there, someone will pick you up." Perfect.

"Where will you stay?" she asked. Then someone from Miami messaged me on WhatsApp — a total stranger — saying, "I've contacted someone there who will host you and take you on a tour tomorrow." Okay. I told the travel agent, "Don't worry, I already know where we'll stay." She said, "Are you sure?" "Yes."

When the driver dropped us off, he said, "You're staying here? This isn't a hotel." I said, "Yes sir, drop us off here." We stayed there — and when I saw Marko, I said, "Carlos, he's the one from the book!" I was so excited. Right away — I knew it was Marko. I was thrilled, like I was in Hollywood. For me, the one who impacted me most was him — when they told him he couldn't marry her. And her brother too — that part really touched me.

When we arrived, Carlos had no idea where he was. It was a surprise. At the New York airport, the airline agent said, "Carlos Carrasco!" and started checking us in. I told him, "Please don't say where we're going — it's a surprise." He had no idea until we landed in Dubrovnik. He loved it — beautiful city, the sea, everything.

When we arrived here, he was like, "What is this place?" I saw Marko and was in awe. I immediately knew it was him. Then Carlos started watching videos about everything and fell in love with the story too. That same day, we went to Mass — it was packed. But somehow, we got in easily. It was raining again. I remembered Fatima — it had rained there too. And I remembered the book: "What begins in Fatima..."

**Carlos:** "...ends here." Like my wife said, she would start reading the book *My Heart Will Triumph*, she would finish it, then read it again, again, again... maybe five times. Then she started explaining it to me, but every time she did, I fell asleep. Or I changed the topic. Until she finally brought me here. Immediately

I started watching videos on **YouTube** — many videos — and I began to love it more and more. I finally understood what she had felt reading the book. I'd finish one video and start another, over and over.

**Karry:** Before dinner. And that's when he understood who Marko was, Mirjana's husband.

**Carlos:** Yes — and I told my wife, "That's the man from the book!" I was talking to Marko — it was amazing. I recognized him right away from the photo in the book — at dinner.

And what impressed me most was my new friend Don, a man from Colorado. He said, "What are you doing at this table? This is a very special table." I said, "I don't know — they just seated us here." He explained that one of the apparitions had happened at that table. We were amazed. We talked for hours, got to know each other. Then Mirjana herself came to the table. We spoke with her for a bit — and then her husband Marko.

**Karry:** Then Mirjana made a gesture, she took out a rosary and gave it to me.

**Carlos:** Then I looked at the videos, at the photo in the book — it was the same rosary she had been using. And my wife — even

**thanked**" (Diary, June 30, 1917). "Conchita," Michel-Marie Philipon, O.P.

## From a Recent Interview with Vicka Ivankovic

**Fr. Livio:** What are the main messages of Our Lady?

**Vicka:** The main messages are prayer, peace, conversion, confession, fasting. The Madonna recommends that we every day we pray all three parts rosary. Yes. And twice a week fasting. Wednesday, Friday only on bread and water.

**Fr. Livio:** How is your health?

**Vicka:** I am well, very well. Even after this fourth operation, I am well.

**Fr. Livio:** And so you are ready to continue to work for the Madonna.

**Vicka:** But of course, I am always ready even in this way with this grace that the Lord gives me that I can offer. Suffer it. Offer it. Yes. For those who are more in need than ourselves.

**Fr. Livio:** Explain a bit to many people who are sick and who suffer what is the value of suffering to save souls.

**Vicka:** Once I have already asked the Madonna. But look Madonna because there are many people who have many crosses, many many pains like this, you know. And the Madonna says, But Jesus never gives what we cannot do. Only that we can do with all our heart and with love ask the Lord. Give me strength that I can go forward. And after when we are ready to ask this, this grace arrives.

**Fr. Livio:** What are the concerns of Our Lady today?

**Vicka:** Her great concern today is for young people and the wars, the wars in the world.

**Fr. Livio:** Give a message to the young people.

**Vicka:** Our lady has already said that everything that happens today in the world, everything is a passing thing. One sees that Satan waits for all our free moments, he waits and then he attacks. But today precisely, he works on young people and he wants to divide our families.

**Fr. Livio:** What does Our Lady say to the priests?

**Vicka:** For the priests, she says that they are her beloved sons. That they should know this, and be devoted to the Holy Bible, the Holy Mass, the sacraments and continue helping others.

**Fr. Livio:** And what can we do for peace in the world?

**Vicka:** Only prayer and fasting, to pray more and to speak less. This is a beautiful thing. Our Lady has said many times that we talk too much and that we pray too little. And we should change this and pray more and talk less.

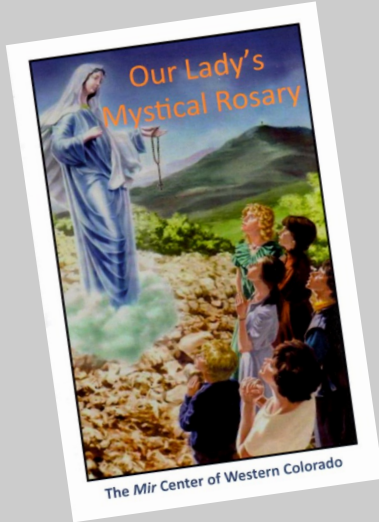
**Fr. Livio:** What must we think about the future?

**Vicka:** We must not worry about the future but think only day by day. We must not worry ourselves what comes tomorrow, the day after tomorrow, nothing. Day by day we go forward...

today — she always carries it. Well, we get to the room. As spouses, we always sleep together. When we get to the room, we see two very small beds.

So I said, “Okay, honey, you sleep there, I’ll sleep here.” I lay down. I don’t know how much time passed, two, three, four hours, no idea. I was sleeping on the left side. Then I moved to the right side of the bed, and right in the middle — I stopped. The room was dark. And in the darkness, I saw a woman wearing a black mantle, holding a baby. My whole body gets chills when I say it. I saw her, turned over, and went back to sleep. In the morning, when we were getting ready for breakfast, it was the first thing I told Karry. She appeared completely in black — it was incredible. I told my friend Don, and Marko, and everyone. When I moved, I was fully awake — I saw her clearly. The next morning they told me, “Whenever that happens, pray a lot — pray and ask.” It really impressed me. When we went back home, I kept rereading the book, looking at the pictures, and at the rosary my wife carried. I told her, “After my baseball season ends, our first trip will be back there.” And here we are. Exactly one year later.

**Karry:** But something even more amazing happened. We got back to the U.S., months passed, he kept working, and he received news from his doctor.

**Carlos:** Every six months I have to get a cancer test. They took my blood. Three weeks later, the doctor called and said I had absolutely nothing. He told me I have absolutely nothing. The numbers all came back... all the same — 000. The previous ones had always come back as plus 01, 02...something like that. But in this test, they were all zero. Completely zero, zero, zero. I felt a lot of happiness. So much happiness. Because it’s not easy when someone tells you that you have cancer. The moment you hear that word, “cancer,” you start thinking about so many things — am I going to die? What’s going to happen to my life, my family? Things like that. But my family was always there. I felt like ‘Why me? Why me?’ But on the outside, I had to be the happiest man, because that’s what I had to show my family — my five kids. Never let them see me defeated or sick. Always, always keep moving forward. And with my teammates too — I had to tell them myself before they heard it somewhere else. So I called a team meeting, and I told them what was going on with me. Their support helped me so much. And I always say this — I truly believe that God put me on this path. I believe He put me here because I’ve connected with so many people who have also had cancer. Even more so because before I found out about my illness, we used to visit hospitals for children with cancer — and afterward, I felt even closer to them. Much closer. Last year, the year before, and this year too, I’ve worked a lot visiting children in hospitals in New York. The joy that you can bring to a child just by visiting the hospital for a day and making them smile. I really believe that’s the most important thing. It’s not easy for them spending 24 hours in a hospital bed. Cancer is something very strong. But just going there and making them smile, that brings me so much happiness. And as long as God keeps giving me health and life, I’ll keep doing it.

Aren’t the messages of Our Lady too good to keep to yourself? Isn’t there a friend or relative that you’d like to add to our mailing list? 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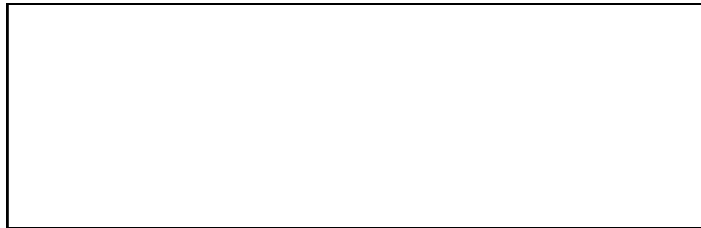
