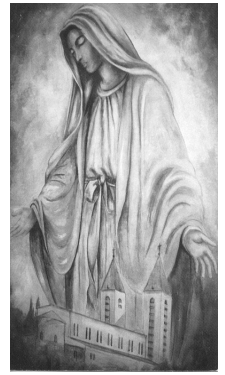

Just six years after reaching the major milestone of feeding one million children each day, *Mary's Meals* announces an even more incredible achievement.

On Wednesday, 8 September, on the Feast of the Birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary, international school feeding charity *Mary's Meals* is delighted to announce that now it is reaching more than two million children in 19 countries with life-changing meals every school day, thanks to an impressive grassroots movement taking action all over the globe.

The work of *Mary's Meals* grew out of Medjugorje, and it is the fruit of Medjugorje and the fruit of prayer.

The landmark achievement of *Mary's Meals* feeding 2 million children every school day will be officially announced and celebrated in the remote desert region of Turkana, Kenya, where communities serve the much-needed daily meals to children attending Early Childhood Development centers. One of the children will make the announcement, which will be broadcast as part of a celebratory online event at 7pm (BST).

The virtual event is open to all and will include reflections from the charity's founder, Magnus, as well as highlights from the celebrations in Kenya and contributions from hundreds of members of the *Mary's Meals* global family. Magnus MacFarlane-Barrow, founder and CEO of *Mary's Meals*, said: "Today we celebrate an amazing moment in the *Mary's Meals* story. Today, two million children ate *Mary's Meals* in a place of education.

"When we set out on this path nearly 30 years ago, we were overwhelmed by people's goodness in donating – and

that's been the story ever since. I thank you with all my heart on behalf of each of those children, for every bit of hard work, for every gift given, for all those unique things each person brings to this enormous *Mary's Meals*' table. Thank you, and please let's keep going forward.

"For every one of those children that ate today, many more are still waiting for *Mary's Meals* to come to their school, so we go on. But this happy day shows us that this vision of ours is possible."

The charity had humble beginnings to say the least: a one-off good deed from a shed in the Highlands of Scotland eventually led to a small school feeding program in Malawi, aiming to bring vital meals to around 200 children in two schools while they learned. Now more than 30% of the primary school population of Malawi enjoys the nutritious meals, served in schools by local volunteers who are determined to help the next generation to build a brighter future.

MacFarlane-Barrow often states that the charity's impressive growth is fueled by countless acts of kindness from people from all walks of life. Among many volunteers and supporters around the world, *Mary's Meals* is extremely grateful for the involvement of young people in Medjugorje. The youngsters have given major support to the *Mary's Meals* team during the Mladifest Youth festival, as well as capturing some incredible 2 million photos at Apparition Hill by Our Lady's Statue.



Recently, Apparition Hill in Medjugorje was glowing in blue T-shirts as more than 80 people – made up of volunteers, guides, Franciscan youth and other friends of the *Mary's Meals* – gathered around the statue of Our Lady to form a figure of 2,000,000 representing the 2 million children currently being fed by *Mary's Meals*. ## From the Diary of Sister Emmanuel

On August 25, 2021, visionary, Marija, received the monthly message:

***“Dear children! With joy I am calling all of you, little children, who have responded to my call: be joy and peace. Witness with your lives Heaven, which I am bringing to you. It is time, little children, that you be a reflection of my love for all those who do not love and whose hearts hatred has conquered. Do not forget: I am with you and intercede for all of you before my Son Jesus, that He may give you His peace. Thank you for having responded to my call.”***

### ***Confession in Medjugorje, summer 1985***

An Italian priest told me about this unique experience. In those days, confessions mostly took place on the lawns surrounding the church. Here and there you would see 2 chairs facing each other, and people were queuing in the fields, at a distance. A woman came and sat in front of him. The priest greeted her with a smile, blessed her and prayed inwardly for her. Very quickly, however, he realized that this woman had something in mind other than a confession. “How handsome you are!” she said to him. “But what are you doing here?”



vain... but the woman continued to insult him rudely, and her vocabulary was enough to make a regiment blush. Then came the blasphemies. People were looking and rather scandalized by what they were hearing. Increasingly humiliated and powerless to find a way out, the priest begged Our Lady to show him how to handle the situation. He couldn't let her leave in such a bad state. The minutes ran by, and the whole scene had already lasted 30 minutes... there had to be a way out!

And she started making fun of him in a loud voice, so everyone could hear her. The priest waited for her to calm down, thinking to himself: “If I chase her away as Padre Pio would probably do in my place, she will lose herself.” He waited in

that day,” he told me, “I experienced the most beautiful confession of my life!”

### ***Like a decaying corpse?***

Jesus told St. Faustina: “... Tell souls where they are to look for solace, that is, in the Tribunal of Mercy. There the greatest miracles take place, and are incessantly repeated... [...] it suffices to come with faith to the feet of My representative and to reveal to Him one's misery, and the miracle of Divine Mercy will be fully demonstrated. Were souls like a decaying corpse so that from a human standpoint there would be no [hope of] restoration, and everything would already be lost, it is not so with God. The miracle of Divine Mercy restores that soul in full... (Diary, 1448)

### ***A true shepherd!***

If I appreciated the overwhelming conversion of this woman, I also appreciated the remarkable attitude of this priest who did not want to leave this soul to its misery without having done everything in his power to bring her back to God. He endured the worst humiliations, vexations and sarcasm without allowing himself to be defeated, so great was his faith in the power of divine mercy, especially for those who are completely lost. He somehow provoked the Savior by His perseverance in faith. What a magnificent example! It reminds me of the Siro-Phoenician woman in the Gospel who ended up winning her case with Jesus for her daughter who was tormented by a demon, after being rebuffed 3 times! “O woman, great is your faith! it shall be done for you as you desire.” (Matthew 15:28)

A priest who prays obtains miracles! There is a reason why Mary prays and begs us to pray for our shepherds. They have a great responsibility before God. Even if seminary studies do not always prepare them to face the most difficult situations in our “lost world”, they hold within them the power of Jesus's priesthood that has been conferred upon them in the sacrament of Holy Orders. A priest who prays can work wonders. A priest who walks hand in hand with the Blessed Mother and who dwells in her intimacy is a happy priest who radiates peace. He will be safely guided and will emerge victorious from the attacks of the Evil One. Through our prayers and sacrifices on their behalf, it is up to us to form walls of fire around our priests for their protection.

### ***An inescapable emergency***

Changing the direction of our lives and entering into true conversion is an absolute emergency. Nowadays, where uncertainties

## Miracles of the Rosary

Our Lady made fifteen promises to Saint Dominic for those who recite the Rosary faithfully. These include the defeat of sin and heresy, the special protection of Our Lady during life, and the assurance of not dying without the sacraments of the Church. Given that so many people throughout history – including countless saints – have had a devotion to the Rosary, it is not surprising that there should be many testimonies to the blessings enjoyed by those who have been loyal to this form of prayer.

### *The Atomic Bomb at Hiroshima*

The following true story is recounted by Fr Paul Ruge and paraphrased below. On August 6, 1945, the first atomic bomb was dropped on Hiroshima. The bomb exploded half a mile from the Jesuit Church of Our Lady's Assumption. More than 100,000 people were killed instantly and thousands more died later from the effects of radiation. However, the church building and eight Jesuit priests stationed there survived. On the morning of the bomb, Fr Hubert Schiffer had just finished Mass, went into the rectory, and sat down at the breakfast table. He had just begun to eat when there was a bright flash of light. Then, in the words of Father Schiffer:

Suddenly, a terrific explosion filled the air with one bursting thunder stroke. An invisible force lifted me from the chair, hurled me through the air, shook me, battered me, whirled me around and round like a leaf in a gust of autumn wind.

The next thing he remembered, he opened his eyes and he was lying on the ground. He looked around and saw that the buildings in all directions were levelled to the ground. As far as he could tell, there was nothing physically wrong with him. Hundreds of thousands were killed or maimed by the explosion.

After the war, army doctors and scientists explained to him that his body would begin to deteriorate because of the radiation. Many of the Japanese people had blisters and sores from the radiation. To the doctors' amazement, Father Schiffer and the other priests had no radiation or ill-effects from the bomb. When asked to account for this incredible situation in which he and his companions were spared, he said:

We believe that we survived because we were living the message of Fatima. We lived and prayed the Rosary daily in that home.

In Nagasaki, St. Maximilian Kolbe's Franciscan Friary was also unharmed. The brothers there also prayed the daily Rosary and they too had no effects from the bomb. Father Hubert Schiffer died in 1982, 37 years after that fateful day. He gave his account of the atomic bomb at the Eucharistic Congress in Philadelphia in 1976. At the time, all eight members of the Jesuit community from Hiroshima were still alive.

### *The Salvation of Brazil from Communism*

Since the apparitions at Fatima, which coincided with the Communist revolution in Russia, Our Lady has been particularly engaged in a spiritual battle with this evil ideology.

In the early 1960s, President Goulart was striving to spread Communism throughout Brazil. It seemed inevitable that he would succeed and the country would become another Cuba. A fifty-nine-year-old retired schoolteacher named Amelia Bastos gathered more than two dozen women acquaintances to form the "Campaign of Women for Democracy", a group that soon expanded to hundreds of thousands of women throughout the country.

These women organized Rosary rallies. One Sao Paulo rally included more than 600,000 women carrying prayerbooks and rosaries as they marched with anti-communist banners. These rallies played a central role in eventually bringing the rule of President Goulart to an end. A Communist takeover of this Catholic country was prevented by peaceful means and by citizens placing themselves under the maternal care of Mary. In gratitude to the Lord, the women of Brazil held an enormous rally the day after they had succeeded in bringing communist rule to an end. The event, which was called the "March of Thanksgiving to God," was participated in by more than one million people.

### *The Rosary: Protecting Life in Extreme Situations*

There are many online testimonials recounting miraculous escapes from danger and death by virtue of fidelity to the Rosary. During the 1994 Rwandan genocide, Immaculée Ilibagiza and seven other women spent ninety-one days hidden in the cramped bathroom of a local pastor's house. Immaculée believed that praying the Rosary spared her from being slaughtered during the genocide, in which her family and more than a million other innocent people were brutally murdered. As well as physical protection, she also recounts the amazing spiritual benefits brought to her by the prayer during this time.

Father Valentine Ezeagu was driving through Imo state in Nigeria on December 15, 2020, on the way to his father's funeral when he was ambushed by four armed men. The priest was unexpectedly freed thirty-six hours later. Reporting his release to his religious superior, Father Ezeagu said the abductors had let him go after seeing him pray the Rosary. Speaking to Aid to the Church in Need (ACN), Father George Okorie, Superior General of the Congregation of the Sons of Mary, Mother of Mercy, said: "When I spoke to Father Valentine, he told me that seeing him praying the Rosary made his abductors confused... They started having a guilty conscience. It made them realize that, since he was wearing a cassock, they had not got the right person, so they gave him some food and released him."

# Federica and the Miracle of the Handkerchief

During an ultrasound done during the fifth month of pregnancy the two expectant parents were given a terrible sentence: their child was suffering from two very serious malformations in the brain: Ventriculomegaly, and Agenesis of the Corpus Callosum. The news stunned the two parents and soon the joy of waiting turned into the most severe darkness since the life prospects for the child were scarce and the advice of the doctors was to abort to prevent unavoidable suffering. At best, after birth the child would have to undergo a very delicate and very difficult surgery and even if the surgery succeeded perfectly, it would have perhaps helped to save the life of the child but the child would have been condemned to a brain-damaged existence, with significant motor, sensory and cognitive difficulties.



the doctors who recommended abortion. However, on the other hand, was the deep faith of the husband who, as a practicing Catholic, opposed with all his strength the suggestion of abortion. So, in their uncertainty, they decided to embark on a spiritual journey together with several priests who helped them to understand the great scope of their mission, their duties as parents, and that life is a gift of God. They reminded the couple that

nothing and no one can suppress what the Lord has established and created. The words of Jesus resounded in their minds "Whoever wants to come after me should deny himself, take up his cross and follow me." The spiritual advice had a positive effect on the couple and they decided to abandon themselves to the will of God and Our Lady who would accompany them by the hand on their difficult journey. Thus the decision was made not to have an abortion and to face the Calvary that awaited them with an expectant faith immersed in prayer.

## *From uncertainty, to hope and then the light*

The young couple lived in conflict with the mother much more rational and influenced by the continuous exhortations by

Praying the Rosary also led to a miraculous cure for Fr. Patrick Peyton, the famous "Rosary Priest". In 1938, after he had emigrated to the United States from Ireland, he became very ill and was diagnosed with advanced tuberculosis, an incurable condition at the time. His sister suggested that he turn to Our Lady. The future Father Peyton consecrated himself to Mary and began devoutly reciting the Rosary. To the astonishment of his doctors, he was completely and miraculously cured. In gratitude, he promised Mary that he would spend his life promoting the Rosary. On becoming a priest, he coined the phrase, "the family that prays together stays together." He was one of the pioneering television evangelists who used the medium to promote the Rosary. In 1992, he died peacefully with Rosary beads in his hands. His cause for canonization is underway.

## *How the Rosary Saved an Entire Squadron in WWII*

The following story from the second world war was recounted to Dominican priest Fr Gabriel Harty by a non-Catholic devotee of the Rosary from Canada.

'It was May, 1940, and we joined the Air Force in late September. We were grouped into squadrons. About thirty to fifty men made up a squadron, along with the squadron leader who gave all the orders and kept us functioning in unity. They told us that we were going overseas and would be in action right away. We eagerly awaited our new squadron leader. As an officer he would, we believed, go straight to the officers' quarters. However, this squadron leader, Stan Fulton, in full uniform, headed for our bunk house, where he settled in with the rest of us. He threw his bag on an upper bunk. Our squadron leader, an officer, sleeping here with us! We liked him at once and our liking and our admiration grew each day. That first night he knelt on the floor and prayed his Rosary in silence. Astounded, we were struck dumb. When he finished, he looked at us with his friendly smile and said, "I hope you guys don't mind a fellow saying

Along this difficult path of the pregnancy the two spouses were supported by an aunt, a nun who went on pilgrimage to Medjugorje. While on pilgrimage, the aunt rubbed a white handkerchief with the image of Our Lady on the of the bronze Risen Christ sculpture that is located behind the church of St. James. This statue has been weeping fluid from the knee in an unexplainable manner for years. And the aunt suggested to the future mother to rest the cloth on her belly, above her womb as an offering, as a gift during her daily recitation of the Holy Rosary.

That night the expectant mother had a dream: she saw a man and a child hand in hand and walking together. The man reassured her by telling her not to worry that nothing bad would happen to the child and that everything would be all right. The pregnant mother identified the two as St. Joseph and the child Jesus. Meanwhile, the routine ultrasound checks continued and the responses were always tragically confirmed. Apparently nothing had improved. In the meantime the couple was advised to go and give birth at the hospital in San Giovanni Rotondo at the 'Home for the Relief of Suffering,' the hospital founded by Padre Pio. At that hospital, there is an excellent department of neurosurgery.

As the due date approached, there was a great surprise when just before the birth the last clinical ultrasound examinations carried out reported that the Ventriculomegaly had disappeared. As soon as the child was born, she underwent numerous clinical checks and multiple further examinations and tests that discovered that the Agenesis of the Corpus Callosum had not produced any damage and the doctors, with great amazement, had to admit that the child was perfectly healthy.

The child, named Federica, despite all the catastrophic predictions made about her state of health and her future, at this point continues to grow strong and healthy. All the negative forecasts and predictions have not had any consequences for the young girl. The Miracle took place through the intercession of Our Lady of Medjugorje and for this reason the whole family went on pilgrimage to Medjugorje to personally thank Our Lady for her powerful intercession.

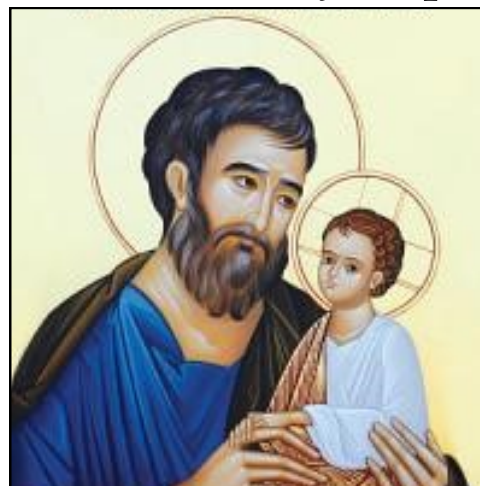
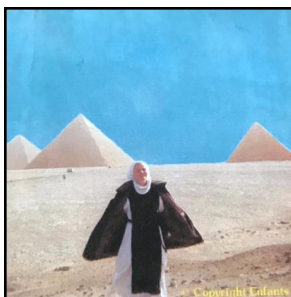

In the sacrament of Reconciliation, receiving absolution from a priest with sincere repentance is to allow the Blood of Jesus to flow in abundance over our soul, to purify and strengthen it. some prayers because where we're going, we're going to need them." Next night, he repeated his prayer session. Although our group had been together for six months at least, I had never seen anyone kneel in prayer, and had no idea that any of our group was Catholic. The third night three of our companions joined Fulton in saying the Rosary. The rest of us did not understand, but we kept a respectful silence. We were weren't slow however on the pick-up. Soon we were all answering the *Hail Marys* and *Our Fathers*.

So, we ended each day in prayer. Shortly enough we were to begin a series of night raids from England over Germany. The evening before, Fulton gave each of us a Rosary. "We shall be in some tight situations, but if you agree to keep the Rosary with you and to say it, I promise you that Our Lady will bring you all back safe." "Sure thing" we replied, little thinking we would be in action for four years, often in dreadful danger. At such times, Fulton's voice would ring through each plane, "Hail Mary..." and we would devoutly respond! We must have said hundreds of Rosaries in the skies. Ours was the only squadron that had not lost a plane or a single life. We said nothing, but we treasured our secret weapon. We did survive, too. All returned to Canada in 1945, fully convinced that Our Lady had taken care of us. So I never forget to keep my Rosary with me and say it every day although I am not a Catholic. When I change my trousers, the first thing I transfer, even before my wallet, is my Rosary.

Then there is the story of Bartolo Longo, a Satanist whose cause for canonization is now underway. Bartolo was born in 1841 to a devout Catholic family. During this period, there was a strong nationalistic movement in Italy and much anti-clericalism. Many of his college professors were ex-priests who had a negative view of the Catholic Church. Bartolo started to dabble in the occult, eventually embracing Satanism. He was consecrated a Satanic priest and promised his soul to a demon. To his family's dismay, he preached against the Catholic faith and presided over blasphemous rituals.

His mental and physical health deteriorated and he sought help from a Dominican priest. Bartolo became a third-order Dominican, but he was still plagued with guilt about his past life, in particular the promise of his soul to a demon. He doubted that God would forgive him. These thoughts nearly drove him to suicide. But then he remembered a homily he had heard on the power of the Rosary. As he later wrote: *Falling to my knees, I exclaimed: 'If your words are true that he who propagates your Rosary will be saved, I shall reach salvation because I shall not leave this earth without propagating your Rosary'*. Bartolo spent the rest of his life promoting the prayer of the Rosary and built the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary in Pompeii, which is Italy's premier Rosary shrine.

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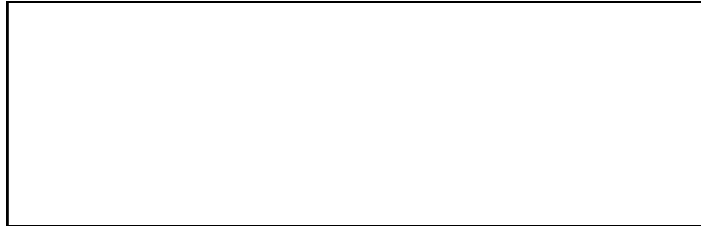
