Through Fasting and Prayer, Wars can be Stopped

How Our Lady Helped End the War in the Balkans

"The columns of tanks were aligned for the last assault on Croatia... The army was preparing for the final offensive." These were the headlines of the newspapers on Sunday, September 21st, 1991: it would have been the end. The situation was dire. But on the same day the Croatian military and leaders ordered a ceasefire. It was a sudden and unexpected liberation from a nightmare. And the truce held and eventually led to peace. We are invited to look upwards because: "the struggle is not against flesh and blood," the Apostle warns us, "but against the rulers of this dark world... therefore put on the armor of God" (Eph 6).

We are certain that it was the incessant prayers that touched the heart of Mary, who prevented the total destruction of the Croatian people. It was certainly the devil who unleashed such a vicious war to erase the name and action of the Blessed virgin Mary, we are all convinced. In the previous messages Mary had prepared us, inviting us to a more intense prayer and renunciation, so serious was the situation. This was a continuation of her plan begun at Fatima:

"Help me so that my plans may be realized and I can help to save souls." So the Blessed Virgin Mary is the protagonist in this story. Many ignore it: so they are still attached to a pattern, perhaps good, but not open to the plan for peace that we are now called to live and build with her.

Let's reread her message of August 25th. Jesus decided on a plan of peace (in us and in the nations) through Mary and those who help Her, but Satan opposes it: he wants war and death. With certain disconcerting events (Russia, Croatia) Satan wants to make believe that Jesus cannot establish peace, that indeed he is stronger than God. In reality, the signs against peace are such and so many that we doubt the strength of God: who can stop an enemy who already appears to have victory in his hands? Let us now understand we are the true protagonists of history: Mary invited us in the June message to read the Scriptures, which speak of these times.

We have learned in these past years to know what Scripture calls "the mystery of iniquity already in place, the son of perdition that rises above every being that is said to be God... even to sit in the temple of God, pointing to himself as God" (2 Thess 2). Satan has used atheistic communism to wipe God off of the earth, imposing himself in God's place. And he has struck very high even to the point of infiltrating certain portions of the Church. But "In the end the Lord Jesus will destroy the wicked with the breath of His mouth" (2 Thess 8).



It is no wonder that with violent anger the political powers unleashed their anger against the Church, first in Russia and then in Yugoslavia with unprecedented ferocity. Father Jozo rightly said "Here in Croatia, Satan fights the final battle against Mary and all who belong to her". It is no coincidence that the symbols of religion in Catholic Croatia the churches (including the cathedrals of Osijelc and Šibenik) have been targeted and hit and convents have been destroyed. Many priests have been imprisoned or expelled. The Commander of the 8th Federal Division himself admitted that one of the favorite targets for their guns were the Catholic churches. The struggle was openly anti-Catholic, because they blame the Pope and the Church for bringing down communism. And also they accuse the Pope of being an ally of the Ustasha and an enemy of greater Serbia. Violent demonstrations were held in Belgrade. But who stopped this war? It cannot be said that it was the Croatian army; that army was much inferior; indeed, the Croatian siege of the federal barracks justified the massive intervention of the army, which first acted only secretly in support of the Chetniks (Serbian partisans) and then sowed among them the greatest destruction.

Let us not speak about the help of the European countries which, after having discussed and planned in vain and called for truces that accomplished nothing and could not agree on how to intervene. The president of France admitted: "They ask us to intervene. Yes, but in whose name? Political union has yet to be established." Less noble interests divided the powerful who had found themselves more united than ever for oil in the Mideast. The international order, led by Freemasonry and only intent on its own economic interests, has abandoned Croatia, unjustly attacked for its legitimate aspiration to independence. And no state would recognize it. So who reversed at the last moment the situation, which then seemed to lead to the total destruction of a people? If the struggle was led by Satan, it could only be won by heaven. "In oppression come to our aid because the salvation of man is in vain. In God we will do great things, and He will annihilate our enemies" (Ps. 60). And God's strength overcame the enemy through the Woman, Our Lady of Medjugorje.

In the early days of the apparitions in Medjugorje, all the people listened attentively to every word of Our Lady. About two months after the beginning of the apparitions, Our Lady said: "**Satan wants to destroy this parish. Dear children, I ask all parishioners to fast on bread and water for three days and to pray the Rosary, in order to overcome Satan**". Everyone, with singular devotion, did what Mary had asked: for three days, with one heart, they fasted and prayed that Our Lady

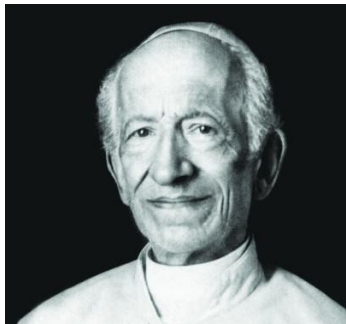
The vision that made Pope Leo XIII tremble

On October 13, 1884, Pope Leo XIII celebrated Holy Mass and then attended another ceremony in thanksgiving. Suddenly, he was seen lifting his head and staring intensely at something above the celebrant. He stared, without blinking, as if filled with a feeling of terror and wonder, and his face changed color. Something strange...something great was happening within him.

Finally, as if coming to his senses, he straightened himself, leaning on his hand with a light but energetic movement. He was seen heading to his private office. His close assistants anxiously followed him and asked him in a soft voice: "Holy Father, do you not feel well? Do you need anything?" He replied, "No, nothing."

Half an hour later, he called the Secretary of the Congregation of Rites and, handing him a sheet of paper, ordered him to print it and send it to all the bishops of the world. What did this sheet contain? Three things: the prayer that we recite at the end of Mass with the faithful and which contains the supplication of the Blessed Virgin, the ardent invocation of the Prince of the Heavenly Militias, and the invocation of God to push Satan back into hell. 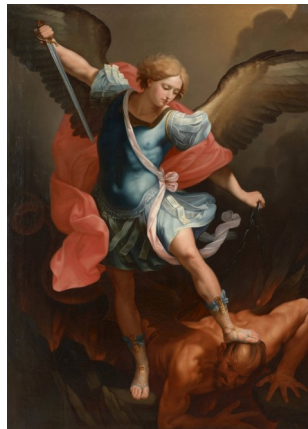
But what did Leo XIII experience in this vision? He explained that just as he was about to leave the altar, he suddenly heard some voices: "After Mass," he said, "I heard two voices, one soft and good, the other guttural and hard; it seemed that they came from next to the tabernacle. It was the devil who was addressing the Lord, as if in a dialogue... Then I

had a terrible vision of hell: I saw the earth open like a grenade. It was shrouded in darkness, and from the abyss I saw a legion of demons coming out of the world to destroy the works of the Church and attack the Church itself, which I saw much reduced. St. Michael appeared and drove the evil spirits back into the abyss. Then I saw the Archangel intervene not at that time, but much later, when people prayed numerous fervent prayers to the Archangel." It is up to us to respond to this call of extreme importance in order to hasten the full victory of the Church, and thereby shorten the sufferings that accompany this struggle!

Here is the prayer to St. Michael the Archangel that Leo XIII wrote at the end of this vision. He ordered it to be recited after each low Mass:

"St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray. And do thou, O Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God, thrust into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls."

Although this obligation was abolished in 1964, St. John Paul II reinstated it and Pope Francis, on September 29th, 2019, on the feast of St. Michael the Archangel, asked all Catholics to recite these three prayers throughout May (the month of the Rosary): a Rosary, then a ***Sub tuum praesidium*** (to Mary) and the prayer to St. Michael the Archangel.

"We fly to your patronage, O Holy Mother of God; despise not our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O glorious and blessed Virgin." (***Sub tuum*** prayer – the most ancient Marian prayer)

To halt a plague

In the year 590, when the plague was raging, causing thousands of deaths, Pope Gregory the Great invited the population to make a procession of supplication and penance in Rome. People would walk slowly, bare foot, with their heads covered. Many dropped dead from the plague during the procession, but the pope asked everyone to continue praying. He himself bore the icon of the Blessed Virgin "Salvation of the Roman people" painted by St Luke, from St. Mary Major to St. Peter's Basilica. As the procession was about to cross the bridge over the Tiber River to reach the basilica, voices of Angels were heard, singing the beautiful hymn "Regina Caeli, Laetare, Alleluia!" After the song of the Angels, pope Gregory saw St Michael appear above the tomb of Hadrian, dressed in sparkling armor, brandishing a sword full of blood. Then the Angel placed the sword back in its sheath. The Pope understood this gesture marked the

Pregnant Pharmacist with Terminal Breast Cancer Chooses Life

Jessica Hanna, a mother of four, was diagnosed with terminal breast cancer when she was 14 weeks pregnant. Several doctors advised her to have an abortion but she declined, choosing life instead.

In an interview with *EWTN Pro-Life Weekly* on Sept. 1, she described how this pregnancy was very different than her previous three saying, "This was God calling me to something so big."

Before getting pregnant, Hanna had noticed a dent in her breast. Doctors misdiagnosed it saying it was benign. Two weeks later she found out she was pregnant. At her first OB-GYN appointment she had doctors look at it again. It then became evident she had breast cancer. Initially, doctors thought it was a small, stage 1 tumor. However, after undergoing surgery, she was told the tumor was 13 centimeters, and stage 4 with metastases to 43 lymph nodes—meaning the cancer likely was terminal. A passionate pro-life advocate who openly shared her beliefs online and with the people in her life, Hanna explained how her pregnancy pushed her to truly live out her strongly held beliefs.

"It was just a journey of, 'Wow. Now you've talked the talk — the pro-life talk. Now you've become the woman everybody uses in their arguments — what if the woman's life is in danger?'" she said. "And now it's time for me to walk the walk." A devout Catholic, Hanna turned to her faith to help get her through the difficult times. After each chemotherapy treatment she prayed at the tomb of Blessed Father Solanus Casey, a soon-to-be saint whose body is buried in Detroit, her hometown.

"I prayed at his tomb for me to be miraculously healed and for my son to come out beautiful and healthy," she recalled.



Another saint she turned to was St. Gianna Beretta Molla. St. Gianna was also diagnosed with a life-threatening illness while pregnant. Hanna explained that, similar to St. Gianna, she chose to do some treatment during pregnancy that wouldn't endanger her baby.

"Many people are not aware chemotherapy can be actually quite



safe during pregnancy," Hanna explained. "I chose the middle road that I would do some chemotherapy with some modifications, and she was a big inspiration for me."

After being diagnosed, she felt God was calling her to something. Unsure of her own future, she made a social media account two days after her diagnosis to share her journey with others and create a prayer community where she could pray with her followers and offer up her suffering for their intentions.

"I thought no suffering should ever go to waste," Hanna said. "I don't know where God is taking me. Is he going to take me to the path where I need to show people how to die gracefully, with his grace and mercy? Or is he going to show a miracle?"

She continued, "I decided to use the social media that no matter what you think is going to happen, it's trust in God that is the most important ... That you are going to abandon your own desires and wants and you're going to leave it at the foot of

the Cross and let him take care of it."

Hanna offers three pieces of advice to women who find themselves in similar situations.

First, being a pharmacist, she encourages women to always seek several medical opinions before making a decision.

She received eight to 10 opinions before moving forward with treatment. A couple of doctors told her to terminate the pregnancy and she explained that "it was not necessary at all. My prognosis didn't change. My treatment plan did not change — pregnant or not pregnant."

Second, go to Our Lady.

"The Blessed Virgin Mary is somebody who knows what it's like to have the sorrows when it comes to your child and the fear," she emphasized. "So, if you go to her, she will take those fears, she will bring them to her son and she will beg with you in order for him to deliver and to bring His mercy upon you and your child."

Lastly, unite your suffering to Christ's Cross.

"Whether it is an IV poke and you're thinking about the nails being driven in his hands and feet, or if you're having an agony waiting upon a scan or test results, think of his agony in the garden," she said.

After she gave birth her scans were clear — there was no sign that cancer had spread to other organs or lymph nodes. Her once-terminal diagnosis was now curable. She named her son Thomas Solanus. Her case has been submitted for the canonization of Blessed Father Solanus Casey.

Deanna's Story: Why Don't You Ask Our Lady?

I was 23 years old when I first came to Medjugorje. I had gone to Catholic school, and I was raised in a Catholic family, but I was lukewarm. In 1988, there were no buildings. It was dirt around the church, and I thought, "How is anybody ever going to know about this? It's out in the middle of nowhere! And why is this church so big?" And of course, back then there was no internet so I didn't know how everyone was going to know about this.

I went to the church. Everybody said, "You should go to confession," so I went into the confessional. I was in a state of mortal sin, but I didn't know it or believe it. I went in and the priest informed me that I was in a state of mortal sin, and I told him I thought he was an old fuddy-duddy and didn't know the modern world. He said, "Well, I can't absolve you."

I said, "That's okay. I didn't need your absolution." He said, "Do you believe Our Blessed Mother is appearing here?"

I said, "Yes. I've read all the books that are out. I believe it, but I'm going to see for myself."

He said, "Why don't you also ask Our Lady to straighten out this conflict you and I have? One of us is correct. Pray to Our Lady. She will straighten us out."

He was a kind guy because I was not very kind. I was kind of rude to him actually. Then I went and started praying to Our Lady. I said, "I believe you're here."

Then I went to church, and this woman that was there with us had a demonic deliverance. All of a sudden, I was aware of the evil one in a very powerful way. It was really frightening to me that this could happen to somebody, and then I started wondering, "Is this going to happen to me?" I was afraid and praying about that.

I supposed the demon was expelled from this woman, but it took some time. I bunked with her too, so I didn't get to sleep very much. She was a very normal, nice woman so the fact that this happened to her was so confusing to me.

That scared me to death. For days I didn't eat very much and I was lost on how this could happen to a person. I was also becoming aware that the evil one was real and maybe hell was real too. From there, I went back to confession. I stood in line in the rain. By the time I got up front an hour later, the priest didn't speak English so I had to go to the next line over. Then I waited through that whole line. I opened the door, and it was the same priest that I was rude to.

It was a totally different confession. I said, "I'm so sorry I was so rude." We had a good confession. I realized I was in a state of mortal sin.

Then I had a beautiful time here. We visited with the visionaries. I encountered Fr. Slavko in a very personal way. In ten days, Fr. Slavko taught me my faith. This was just him speaking to the young groups. I learned so much, most importantly, I came to the realization that Christ was in the Eucharist which I didn't fully understand or really know.

They said Adoration was after Mass so I went to Adoration not knowing what it was. I was kneeling in a packed church. I was like, "This is beautiful."

He was talking to the monstrance. I thought to myself, "He's talking as if Jesus is truly here," and then it occurred to me that Jesus was there. Everything dawned on me about the Eucharist. That was life-changing, that Jesus was truly in the Eucharist.

And confession. When you have a good confession, and you walk out of there freed, now the journey begins because now you have to change. That's what happened to me. Going home, the need to change began.

I came here in April. I have really bad feet so I decided to go up Križevac (Cross Mountain) by myself. When I was young, I went up in my bare feet and it was easy. I was young and fit. The mistake I made was I didn't realize you were supposed to take your shoes with you.

So here I am, now 57, and I thought, "Our Lady, I've done everything I feel like I can do for my kids. I don't know what more I can do, but I'm going to go up with my shoes off." I took my shoes off and I carried them because I wanted to come down with them.

I got diverted. There was a spot where I thought it was easier on my bare feet. I started walking and it seemed right, but that led me to what was like walking on a field of Tonka toys. Every step hurt. From there, Our Lady led me off the main path. I was on my hands and feet. There were thorns. Every step I was getting thorns in my feet and thorns in my hands. It was for my children's conversion. I said, "Our Lady, please figure out a way to start their conversion. Even if you just plant the same seed you planted in my heart, I will be so grateful."

I got home and I had a check in the mail for enough money to bring all of us here to Medjugorje. It was a refund from an overpayment or something. I knew this was the only opportunity that we may have to have all of us, all my children, together at the same time. So we booked our tickets.

It's truly the happiest time of my life right now because I believe they're going to be saved. Our Lady has planted a seed of conversion in their hearts. Now it's up to them. They're adults, with the exception of Luke. Our Lady has given them the same seed She gave to me, and now it's up to them. They have the same choice. They immediately felt things. I know each one of them has had a beautiful experience in just a week. Now I can go home and continue to pray for them because I know Our Lady has started it. They all had beautiful confessions. To see your children go to confession and come out of there with tears in their eyes, I just can't explain it. I'm so thankful. For them to experience God's love and His mercy. I can't even explain it.

end of the plague in Rome. In 1304, Pope Benedict XI had a large bronze statue of St Michael placed on Hadrian's tomb. Since then, it has been called "Castel Sant'Angelo".



What about the coronavirus? In 2021, for Palm Sunday, a historic event of great impact took place at the Sanctuary of St. Michael the Archangel of Mount Galgano. To stop the coronavirus, the Rector of the Sanctuary, Father Ladislao Sucky and Fathers Micheliti took with them the Eucharist, a relic of the Holy Cross and the sword of St. Michael, and they blessed the city, all of Italy and the whole world.

Why recall these events today? Because love is becoming increasingly cold in the nest of human life, that is, the family as the Creator created it! Of course we are witnessing some very beautiful initiatives of faith, but the spiritual battle that is raging more than ever must awaken us from a lethargy of the soul. This is vital and crucial. Family prayer, which creates and weaves the union of hearts, has given way to 1000 other things. And yet love is what saves, love heals, it is love that gives peace! God is love, and without God, without the prayer that gives God to souls, the family has no future.

Beware, we are at a crossroad! Now is the time to make a choice: turn right or turn left? Return to God, or let yourself be seduced by the world. The future of every one of us depends on this choice. Mary warns us in her wonderful maternal way! **"I am listening to your cry and prayers for peace. For years, Satan has been fighting for war. That is why God sent me among you to guide you on the path of holiness, because humanity is at a crossroad. I am calling you to return to God and to God's commandments, that it may be good for you on earth, and that you may come out of this crisis into which you have entered..."** (March 25, 2022)

Here, Mary is repeating the words of St. John Paul II, in his Act of Consecration to Mary on October 8th, 2000: "Today more than ever humanity is at a crossroads. And once again, salvation is entirely and only, O Holy Virgin, in your Son Jesus."

"Help me with prayer, little children, that Satan may not prevail. His power of death, hatred and fear has visited the earth. Therefore, little children, return to God and to prayer, to fasting and to renunciation, for all those who are downtrodden, poor, and have no voice in this world without God. Little children, if you do not return to God and His commandments, you do not have a future. That is why He sent me to you, to guide you..." (February 25, 2022)

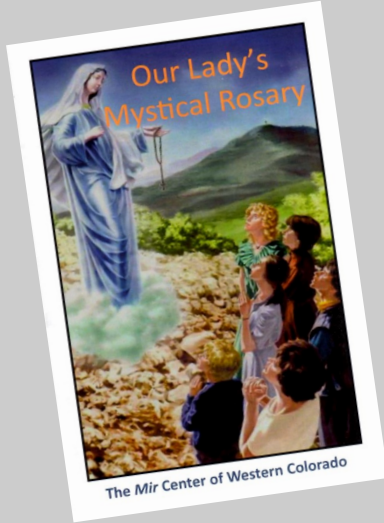
might crush the head of the serpent and on the fourth day she said: **"Dear children, I thank you for your prayers and your fasts because Satan's plan has failed, we have won!"**

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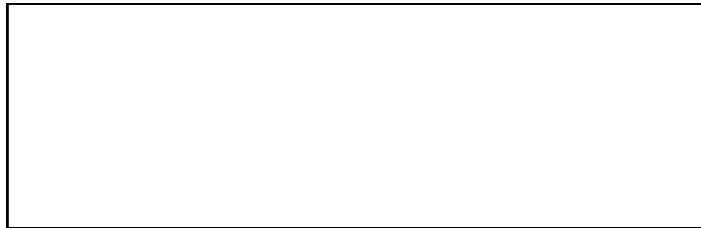
