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The Secrets of Medjugorje Compared to the Secrets of Fatima

In essence, the revelation of Fatima on July 13, 1917 and Sister Lucy's subsequent visions anticipate the content of the Secrets of Medjugorje. Nevertheless, there is a fundamental difference. Unlike the secrets of Fatima, those of Medjugorje will be revealed before they occur. It is a detail of extraordinary importance, which opens up a completely new perspective. The fact that each one will be revealed three days before it happens will prepare us which, believer or unbeliever, can only focus attention on the small village in Herzegovina, now known all over the world.

In a particular way, it will be the third secret, with the permanent sign left on the mountain, that will ask all of humanity and, ultimately, every conscience, whether to believe and take seriously the presence of Mary, or whether to harden their hearts, as Pharaoh did with the ten plagues that struck Egypt.

The fact that the announcement will be made three days before and then the event will take place is a strong reason for credibility and a help given by the Lord to a humanity in the grip of fear and anguish. In those three days, which recall those of the Lord's passion and resurrection, men will have time to reflect and to make their own choices, on which their salvation or ruin will depend.

The time frame of the secrets is not known, but it has already been fixed from above and will not be changed, says Mirjana. In fact, each of them already has its own day and time. However, the effects will be different depending on whether men convert or harden their hearts even more.

Each secret will be a call to faith and a sign of mercy. As events unfold, Mary's light will become ever more intense, because men will be able to know her love as a Mother. God alone knows what will happen in hearts when Satan unleashes his full fury to destroy the world and Our Lady reaches out to protect all those who desire it.

To feed curiosity with abstract speculations would be misleading and typical of false prophets. Our Lady has revealed to us the essentials, from which we draw the certainty that we are facing a decisive moment in the eschatological battle, which will see God's victory and open to humanity a perspective of love and peace.

Our Lady of Medjugorje has warned us, recommending her children to put on the armor of God now, so as not to arrive unprepared for the crucial moment. She exhorted us by saying that those who pray are not afraid of the future and those who fast are not afraid of evil. God is patient, as Jesus was with the apostles, but then the moment comes when delay is no longer possible and one cannot postpone one's choice.

All will have to decide which side to take, whether with God or with Satan. From the beginning it has been like this because God asks for love, but does not impose it on anyone. The God they will have to invoke is the only true God, the Son of Mary, the Word who became flesh in her virginal womb. In vain will men cling to their idols and invoke their false gods. Only one is the Living One and the Savior of the world and it will be the humble Handmaid of the Lord who will point Him out to humanity about to be crushed by the flood of Satan's wickedness.

Three Things Demons Don't Want you to Know

One of the torments for those afflicted by demons is a voice in their heads that constantly belittles and tears them down. In hell, demons constant condemn and disparage its human denizens. Demons bring this "hell" with them when they roam the earth. Thus, the demonically afflicted in this life experience aspects of hell. A destructive mental torment is one of them. But demons are inveterate liars. Everything they say, unless commanded by God to tell the truth, is either a lie or a manipula-

tion. What they do not want you to hear or to know is the Truth. I offer three truths that the demons do not want you to know:

+First: You are beautiful. God made you in His image and He is beautiful. Demons try to entice you to believe that you are worthless. The Truth is you have an unrepeatable supernatural dignity and worth. Moreover, because of your baptism, confirmation and Eucharist, you are now a temple of the Holy Spirit. Demons want you to deny this and they tempt you to choose evil and sin.

+Second: You are infinitely loved by God. Demons want you to think that God doesn't care about you. They tell you that you are alone and abandoned. They try to isolate their intended victims and then darken their thinking. The Truth is that you have a divine love that is unique to you. God focuses His infinite love on you and showers you personally with an overflowing abundance of His love.

+Third: You are forgiven. Demons constantly torment us with our sins and weaknesses. They will tell us that we are hopeless and rejected. They tempt us to despair. And they will tell you that everyone is better off without you. These are all demonic lies. Jesus paid the price for your sin. The Truth is God forgives your sins: your sins are swallowed up in the ocean of God's mercy. God the Father is waiting at the edge of his property to welcome you, the prodigal child, to His and to your home.

Whenever you hear messages that you are worthless, unloved, alone and rejected, be assured that these messages ultimately come from the bowels of hell. Sadly, these lies are sometimes conveyed to us by other human beings including family members, even parents.

When we hear these demonic lies, whether directly from demons or from the mouths of humans, we might use the three R's: I reject it; I rebuke it; I renounce it, and I cast it out. We then replace it with the Truth: God made me beautiful; He loves me with an infinite love; all of my sins are swallowed up in His mercy. Moreover, God has a place for you in His home, and He is waiting. Focus your heart on Him so that when the time comes, the saints and angels will escort you to your heavenly home. That is the Truth!

May is the month of Mary

In this “month of Mary”, I would like to tell you a beautiful testimony about the incredible power of the Rosary, a miraculous event which affects me personally because it happened to my father.

During the Second World War, he was arrested by the Gestapo because of his activities as part of the Resistance and was deported to Germany. His mother was a widow, and my father was his only son. This woman of faith entrusted everything to the Virgin Mary who she loved so dearly. This deportation lasted for three long years. What did my grandma do when she had no news? She prayed rosary after rosary and believed with her whole heart and soul that her son would come back. Her faith in Our Lady was unshakeable. Out of the 10 men who were arrested alongside my father, he was the only one to come home.

Here is one of the most remarkable fruits of this tireless prayer: One day, when my father, like all his fellow prisoners was tired and exhausted, the SS on guard duty asked the prisoners to transport some rocks from a quarry to a building site. Every prisoner was given a rock to transport. When my father saw the rock which had been allocated to him, he knew that his time had come because it was impossible for him to lift this enormous rock. He also knew that if he didn't carry the rock, between the dogs and the weapons of the SS, death would be his end, as this had happened to some of the other prisoners.

Standing near his rock, in distress, he lifted his eyes and saw a nearby house. On the façade, there was an alcove from which presided a statue of the Virgin Mary. As soon as he saw this statue, he silently cried out “Mary, save me!” At that very moment, the rock was no longer heavy, and as my father told us, it became “as light as a piece of confetti!”

This extraordinary instance of divine protection, amongst others, has allowed me to be born. My father never omitted to pray his Rosary every day. He always forgave those who wished him harm in the concentration camps.

Pope Leo XIVth is open to Medjugorje

How immense was our joy as we welcomed Pope Leo XIV on the evening of May 8th on the feast of the Virgin of the Rosary of Pompeii! Numerous prayers and sacrifices were offered to God during the Conclave after the passing of Pope Francis, praying that, with the Holy Spirit, the Cardinals would choose the new vicar of Christ for our time.



The nomination of Pope Leo XIV has kindled great excitement and I am the first to share this enthusiasm for many reasons! One being that Pope Leo XIV is open to Medjugorje and has advised several people to come here. Day by day, we are going to learn more about this Pope, who has already proven himself as a good Shepherd through the ministries that have previously been entrusted to him.

Our excitement should not mean we forget to pray. We need to continue to pray with all our hearts and raise up to God a particularly intense prayer, because the enemies of Christ and the Church are many and they never rest! Fr. Dan Reehill on the Eucharist, God's Preferred Form of Worship

Transcript of a YouTube video (edited for length and clarity)

In the sixth chapter of the gospel of John, Jesus is speaking about Himself being the bread of life, the living bread that's going to impart His life to us so that we would have divine life. And what He is really talking about, He's talking about how He desires us to commune with Him. This is how I desire you would worship. When I ascend to my Father, this is how I would desire you worship. Do this in memory of me. This is very important. This is probably the most important thing. God has always had a particular way He wanted to be worshiped, right from the beginning. You go back to Adam and Eve. What was the way He established for the first two? He said "You will commune with me. Everything is yours. I ask one thing: don't eat from that tree and by not eating from that tree you'll be showing me you how much you love me." This basically was worship. Of course, they failed. Everything changes. Sin enters the world. But even going forward, we look to the patriarchs of Abraham, Moses. Worship was established by God, how He wanted to be worshipped.

The book of Leviticus is not the easiest book for people to read in the Bible, but go read it. It's exactly God's instruction on how to worship Him. For the Old Testament people, the Israelites, He provided great detail. The first chapter is the Holocaust, the offering of the flesh that would be consumed. The second chapter is the seed offering, the offering of the grain. It's starting to make sense. The third chapter, the offering of peace, the peace offering that would put man and God around the same table, sharing a meal together as one. With the holocaust one portion would be given to the people and one to God, and then the sprinkling of the blood. Then He establishes a tent. Then God establishes the temple and what is to happen at the temple. And God said there will be priests set apart. They will offer the sacrifice. That's always the role of the priest, to offer the sacrifice. There will be an animal sacrificed. There will be blood and the blood will be sprinkled on the altar and on the people and God will be present there.

Now, just picture for a moment. At the Easter vigil and on Easter Sunday the priest comes around with the holy water and he goes up and down the aisle. He's sprinkling everybody. Some people are bothered. Why is holy water bothering you? It should only bother the devil. But some people don't like it, because, oh please, I have my best clothes on, don't sprinkle me. I'm going to take a broom next year. But imagine if it was blood. This is what they were doing with blood, sprinkling the people. it was a very earthy experience. You would leave there covered in blood and that's the point. They would never forget what was just done. They sacrificed to God because He asked them to worship this way: priest, altar, blood, sacrifice. And this goes on for many, many years.

Then Jesus enters the picture and he spends his whole life as a witness of how to live as a perfect human being although He's divine in His humanity. He gives us this great example. But that's not the main purpose of His coming. His main purpose was to offer His life on the cross and so on the night of the Passover this great feast where they celebrate their liberation from slavery, He changes the Passover meal into the Mass and He changes the

bread and wine into His body and blood and He gives it to His friends and says "This is my body, this is my blood. Do this in memory of me." And this is the beginning of the sacramental system that He established on that great day, on Holy Thursday when he instituted the Holy Eucharist and the priesthood.

So, we kind of get that. We know this. But then He dies and He rises and eventually, He ascends to His Father and sends us the Holy Spirit. And the Church has a great Pentecost and the Holy Masses begin. They're mainly hidden, because people are trying to kill them. But the Masses are happening immediately.

Then in 70 AD something happens. The temple is destroyed. It's God's way of telling the Jews that this way of worship is over. I have this new covenant that I'm desiring you to do. It's been established by my Divine Son, by His offering on the cross and He has left you His body and blood as food for the journey through this life to arrive at the shores of heaven.

Okay, we get this. But the Jews didn't at all. They didn't get it. Well, some did, many came over, but many of them did not. What do they do, they say "Well, we can't worship the way we were told to worship, so we'll devise our own worship now. Get rid of the priests we don't need them. There's no sacrifice. Let's get more rabbis and we'll build more synagogues and now we'll just go into the synagogue, we'll read the word of God and we'll have a teaching on it and then we'll all go home." This is Man-made. God did not ask for this, this was not God's design. But they've been doing this for 2,000 years. You would think at some point somebody would say, maybe we missed the boat. It's been a while and the temple never got rebuilt

Okay, but even this we can accept. Maybe they just have blinders on so they can't see the reality of what has happened. However, when we had divisions in the Catholic Church, and by the way, there was only one Church. It's just the Catholic Church. That's it. But then we have the breakaways, the Protestants, Luther all these other tangential Christian churches, they break off and start their own churches, which was never part of the plan. What do they do? No priest, no altar, no blood, no sacrifice. They adopt the inert model. Isn't that shocking? It should be shocking. This is what they do. I live in Tennessee. It's Baptist. Their Rome is Nashville. That's how they worship. No priest, no altar, no blood, no sacrifice.

Is it pleasing to God? I'm sure it is. They're reading the word of God. That's a good thing. But it's not the way God prescribed it to be. So, when we look at this gospel today, when Jesus is establishing this new sacrament of His own body and blood, you know what happens. They say "This is too hard, we can't do this." In the scriptures initially, there's no numbering at all. But ironically this turns out to be John 666. These are first people that turn away from the Eucharist. It's the mark of the Antichrist. And it's still happening today. Even as I prepare people for coming into the Catholic Church, most of them have no idea there's a difference between the Catholic Church and the Baptist Church and the Church of Christ and all the other

An Interview with Vicka with Comments on the Third Secret

Vicka of Medjugorje held five interviews live on **Radio Maria** which are important historical documents on the apparitions of Medjugorje and a testimony of profound Marian spirituality.

Father Livio: I would now like to take a look at the future which often fills us with anguish and fear. Our Lady said in one of her very consoling messages that those who pray are not afraid of the future.

Vicka: But I'm sure of this. He who prays is not afraid of anything.

Father Livio: In your opinion, why did Our Lady say this phrase?

Vicka: Because many people think about what's to come and let fear stop them. Our Lady wants to open her eyes to us by saying: "Do not be afraid of the future. I am with you" Our Lady wants to tell us that she opens all the paths for us, only that we want it. All roads are open to God.

Father Livio: During these apparitions, Medjugorje has become one of the most important spiritual centers on earth and it cannot be denied that good always conquers new hearts. But in the meantime it would seem that the evil has also grown. Will Our Lady be able to build the new world of peace, as she calls it?

Vicka: Of course She will.

Father Livio: It is not for nothing that she came as the Queen of Peace.

Vicka: Yes, she came to bring peace to the whole world.

Father Livio: The popes often speak of the civilization of love that we must all build together with good will and naturally with the grace of God. In your opinion, will we reach this goal through trials and suffering?

Vicka: Suffering is never lacking and serves to make us stronger.

Father Livio: Now that the third secret of Fatima has been revealed to us, we know that it concerned a difficult time, of wars and persecutions, for the world and for the Church, in particular for the Holy Father. Do we have to wait for something like this for the ten secrets of Medjugorje too?

Vicka: As for secrets I don't have much to say. For now I have nine and I'm waiting for the tenth. If and when Our Lady wants to explain them, then we will know more.

Father Livio: However, even if the secrets are truly secret, the fact remains that they concern the future and that therefore the apparitions of Medjugorje still have much to reserve for us.

Vicka: Sure, sure.

Father Livio: The game is not over yet.

Vicka: No, no.

Father Livio: We are still in the first half.

Vicka: It's just started.

Father Livio: Among the similarities between Fatima and Medjugorje there is also the sign. In Fatima, Our Lady had promised it for her last apparition, that of October 1917. Even in Medjugorje there is talk of a sign. The visionaries of Fatima were very sure that Our Lady would give it. Are you so sure about it too?

Vicka: You see, Father Livio, Our Lady has given a great possibility, a great gift to see this sign.

Father Livio: Have you already seen it?

Vicka: We have already seen it and when the time comes there will certainly be a sign on the mountain of the apparitions.

Father Livio: Will everyone be able to see it?

Vicka: Everyone and it remains forever.

Father Livio: Does it remain forever?

Vicka: Yes, it remains forever as proof that Our Lady was here among us.

Father Livio: Do we have to come to Medjugorje to see it?

Vicka: You have to come here to us, here on the mountain.

Father Livio: Do we have to go up the mountain or can we see it from afar?

Vicka: But, Father Livio, you want me to slowly tell you everything....

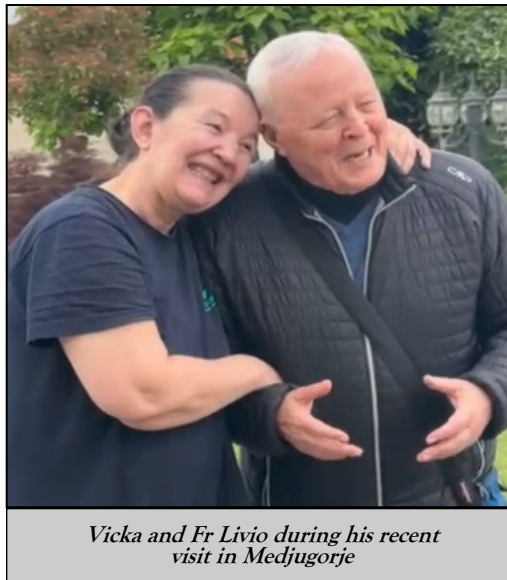
Father Livio: I ask you because Jakov said that to see him we must come to Medjugorje. It is not difficult to imagine a large crowd of people at that moment...

A field of daisies for Pope Leo XIV

To respond to this urgent call from Mary, I am proposing a very simple and concrete action which has already proved effective in the past. The goal of this initiative is to surround the Holy Father with fervent prayers and to create a wall of protection around him.



See this design? This beautiful daisy has 7 petals, one for each day of the week. In the center, on the yellow flower head, Pope Leo XIV's name is written. On each petal, we will write the name of someone who is willing to pray a Rosary for the protection of the Pope on a particular day of the week. To do this, we need 7 volunteers so that the seven rosaries are prayed each week. This initiative is not cumbersome, because each volunteer is simply saying one Rosary each week for the protection of the Pope.

But of course, you have to commit to it! This demands faith and perseverance - two very Marian virtues. If a family cannot gather 7 people, they could link up with another family or with members of a prayer group. When there is a will, there's a way! You will not regret taking part in this wall of protection!

30,000 denominations we have in America. They don't realize there's a difference because it's not being taught. Of course, the other churches aren't going to say it. But know this. You are part of a very, very unique group because the greatest thing that's going to happen on the planet today is right here, right here on this altar. God will come down. He will be fully present today: body, blood, soul and divinity. He will even give Himself over to you to feed your souls, your bodies, to transform you and invite you to participate in His divine life. We have a God that wants us to participate in his divine life. Can you imagine we have such a God? It doesn't matter what else is going on in the world, this is the greatest gift God has given to man.

Believe me, we don't deserve it but that's the point. God desires it. That's why it happens. By your baptism, another thing that I think a lot of people don't realize the magnitude of, what baptism does for us. You become by grace what Jesus is by His very nature; a son or daughter of God. How can God do such a great thing for us? When I teach the kids at school, my prior parish, 400 kids come to mass three days a week. I ask what is the goal of your life? Most of them just stare back. I don't know, to get to recess? No, the goal of your life is to get to heaven. Heaven is the goal. Then, within a few months I would say, what is the goal of your life? Heaven! 400 kids scream, heaven—it's the only time they get to scream in church, which they love to do.

One day I said, "Okay how do you get there?" Silence. And then a little boy screamed out "You gotta die." Right. At the end of life, we will die and God willing, if we've given our life over to Jesus and loved him and given everything for His glory, we will make our way home to heaven. That's the goal, that's the prize. If you don't get to heaven, you lost. It's that simple. There are only two places at the end of life, heaven or hell. Purgatory is a pitstop. You're either going to be a winner in heaven or you're going to be a loser in hell. That's it. You could amass all the toys on the planet. You could be a billionaire. You could have homes on every continent. You could have yachts and all that other great stuff. But if you go to hell, you lost.

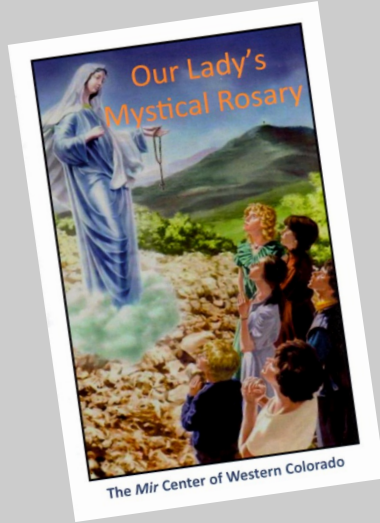
So, today as we embark on this new papacy with this new pope make a new commitment to become a saint. I would say, do it out loud. Go off somewhere quiet during your adoration time today or during the apparition and just say, "Jesus make me a saint. Remove anything in my life that's blocking me from becoming the great saint you made me to be." Because that's what you were created to be. Every single person was created to be a saint and we get to choose to cooperate with that grace or we can reject that grace. You're here in a very privileged part of the world. And our lady one day grabbed me by the back of my neck and she said "I have other plans for you, get over here." Right here in Medjugorje in 1998, I came back to God and His Church. I left Wall Street and I became a priest. That is only by grace. And so for you who have children and grandchildren that are far away from the Church, do not despair. Commend them over to our lady and say "Go get them." She wins every time...

Vicka: But, father, you are not too old yet. But I think so and then there are still many things to do.

Father Livio: Indeed, **Radio Maria** is installed in various languages in only thirty nations of the world and we would like to reach all of them.

Vicka: You still have a lot to do.

Father Livio: I understand. Retirement is far away. Will it be a sign of hope?

Vicka: Yes, of hope.

Father Livio: With joy?

Vicka With joy, but a beautiful thing, understand?

Father Livio: I wanted to insist on the sign because the Church, to evaluate the validity of an apparition, checks whether the prophecies have been fulfilled.

Vicka: It's normal.

Father Livio: The attitude of the Church is wise. Could the sign therefore be a confirmation for the Church that the apparitions are true?

Vicka: Of course. Our Lady has already said once that we must not worry about these things, but rather about welcoming the messages and living them. We have to leave everything else up to her.

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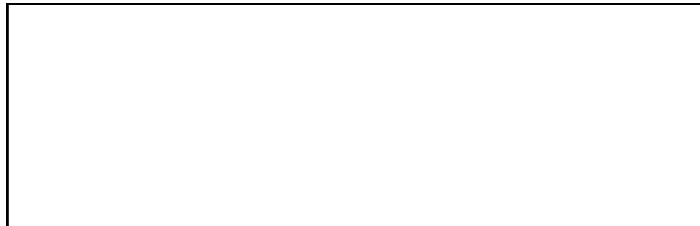
